Student Ministries (6th – 12th grade) and to support adult discipleship and community building within the wider church.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Commitment to make City Church your home church and faith community.
- Alignment with the City Church Statement of Faith, Church Member Covenant, and Purpose Statement.
- Bachelor's degree minimum; Master's degree in seminary education in-process or completed preferred.
- A working knowledge of Scripture and ability to nuance interpretation in teaching and one-on-ones.
- Ability to understand, relate to and build relationships with junior/senior high school students/families.
- Ability to effectively communicate the truths of the Bible to students.
- Proven track record of recruiting, training, and sustaining a volunteer leadership team.
- Ability to plan, develop, coordinate, manage and implement all aspects of a student ministry.
- Self-starter with a strong work ethic, organizational, communication, and time-management skills.
- Responsible and dependable with details, information, and tasks.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office, Macintosh programs and general computing skills.
- Ability to stand for extended times and ability to lift, carry, and/or move 30 lbs. as needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES – Student Ministries

- Create a group students love and want to invite their friends to, with weekly programing and special events where students feel they belong to a community of loving peers and caring adults, are invited into a relationship with Jesus, challenged to become more like Jesus, and equipped to serve others.
- Develop relationships with a broad number of students, families, and leaders through programming, intentional one-on-ones, and outside relational contact (i.e. attending games/events, lunch, etc.).
- Recruit, equip and mobilize a team of committed volunteers who care about and minister to students.
- Effectively communicate biblical truth in both large and small group settings.
- Articulate a multiyear ministry plan for what our students should know, experience and do in the years they are in student ministries.
- Coordinate and lead periodic service-learning projects and short-term mission trips.
- Maintain consistent communication with parents, students and volunteers.
- Effective administration and management of ministry within the approved budget.
- Supervise and lead any student ministry intern, apprentice, or staff.
- Coordinate with Children's Pastor for a seamless transition to Student Ministry, and on Family initiatives.

RESPONSIBILITIES – Community Life

- Initiate and develop a young adult ministry with goal of growth numerically and in Christlike formation.
- Support the pastoral team by providing leadership to adult discipleship or community life areas such as church-wide social events, Growth Groups (small group ministry), Sunday Morning Communities pastoral oversight, or a church-wide retreat, depending on gifts, training, abilities and interests.
- Meet regularly with congregants for connection, mentoring, prayer, and care support.
