## Liability Release

We (I), in consideration for our child/youth attending King of Glory Children, Youth, and Family Ministry activities and being under the age of 21, do hereby release, forever discharge and agree to hold harmless King of Glory Lutheran Church in Dallas and the directors thereof from any and all liability, claims of demands for personal injury, sickness or death, as well as property damage and expenses, of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred by the undersigned and the child-participant that occur while said child is participating in King of Glory Children, Youth, and Family Ministry trips and activities.

Furthermore, we (I) [and on behalf of our (my) child-participant] hereby assume all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage and expense as a result of participation in recreation and related activities involved therein.

Further, authorization and permission is hereby given to said church to furnish any necessary transportation, food and lodging for this child.

The undersigned further hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify said church, its directors, employees and agents, for any liability sustained by said church as a result of negligent, willful or intentional acts of said child, including expenses incurred attendant thereto.

We (I) are the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of this child, and hereby grant our (my) permission for her (him) to participate fully in King of Glory Lutheran Children, Youth, and Family Ministry activities, and hereby give our (my) permission to take said child to a doctor or hospital and hereby authorize medical treatment, including but not in limitation to emergency surgery or medical treatment, and assume the responsibility of all medical bills, if any.

Further, should it be necessary for the child/youth to return home due to medical reason, disciplinary action, or otherwise, we (I) hereby assume all transportation costs.

Either or both parents must agree. If divorced or separated, custodial parent or legal guardian must agree. This form is valid for a period covering January 1, 2026 – December 31, 2026.
