## GREETING CIRCLE

For example, when the word axle is introduced, children will look at a real axle on a tricycle and another on a toy truck. Then when the word appears in a story or a lesson, children will connect the word with the experience they had during Greeting Circle. You may be surprised to hear your child using these new words in everyday conversations. Some of the words introduced during this unit are: travel, destination, axle, aviator, and harbor.

## MATH

In Theme 7,
The children will be arranging objects, sets, and numbers in order. We will practice putting things in order by size (small to large or short to tall). Other times we will put things in order by quantity or how many are in a set (three candles, two candles, one candle). And, we will learn to use ordinal numbers (first, second, third) to describe an object's position: The green car is first in the line. The blue car is second. The white car is third.
Find fun ways to practice this important math concept with your child.
*Notice who is first, second, or third at the grocery checkout counter or at the stoplight.
*Arrange cups of crayons from the cup with the fewest number of crayons to the cup with the most crayons.
*Arrange family members from tallest to shortes $\dagger$
