Are you ready for the SCRIP Gift Card Sale? Not sure what SCRIP is? Below is some valuable information on the SCRIP program. You also may contact Kelly Money at kmoney@dayonechristianacademy.org with any questions.

What is RaiseRight, formerly SCRIP program? "SCRIP" means substitute money. When you purchase a SCRIP card you are purchasing gift cards that are used just like cash. The SCRIP card is issued by national and local retailers where you already shop. These merchants want to support non-profit organizations and in return ask you to support them by shopping with scrip cards at their stores. Every purchase will earn revenue for our school.

How can you help? Order SCRIP card(s) using the form in your child's cubby on November 5 and our school will earn a percentage from each card ordered.

How to order the SCRIP cards: Forms will be placed your child's cubby and additional forms will be provided in the Lobby Area. (1) Review the list of available SCRIP cards. (2) Complete the order form. (3) Submit your order form with payment to the office. The order will be submitted Friday, December 6. (4) Your order will process in approximately 1 week. You will be notified when the cards are in, and you may pick them up in Mrs. Money's office.
