During this theme, the children will pretend to "smell flowers" (inhale) and "blow out (unlit) birthday candles" (exhale) as they practice deep breathing. They will connect with their classmates as they learn to greet new friends. Children will also commit to help keep the classroom safe and take responsibility for their own actions.
