
What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.





Philippians 4:10–13






#### \*Nicene Creed

Let us use it as a guide as we ask our heavenly Father's continued care. We, the people of the United States.


We recognize Your grace, O God, in creating us, calling us to faith, and leading us totally by grace. We thank You for placing us within this great land.




#### \*Proper Preface
