<b>Jonah 1:1</b> – God's word comes to Jonah	"The word of the Lord came to Jonah"	<b>Jonah 3:1</b> – God's Word came to Jonah	"The word of the Lord came to Jonah a second time"
<b>Jonah 1:2</b> – The message Jonah is to convey	"preach against it"	<b>Jonah 3:2</b> – The message Jonah is to convey	"Proclaim to it the message I give you."
<b>Jonah 1:3</b> – Jonah's response	"Jonah ran away from the Lord"	<b>Jonah 3:3</b> – Jonah's response	"Jonah obeyed the word of the Lord and went to Nineveh"
<b>JONAH AND GOD'S WORLD</b>			
<b>Jonah 1:4</b> – The warning from God	"Then the Lord sent a great wind onto the sea..."	<b>Jonah 3:4</b> - The warning from God	Jonah proclaimed, "Forty more days and Nineveh will be overthrown."
<b>Jonah 1:5</b> – The pagans' response	"The sailors were afraid and each cried out to his own god."	<b>Jonah 3:5</b> – The pagans' response	"The Ninevites believed God. A fast was proclaimed..."
<b>Jonah 1:7-15</b> – The pagans respond to God, not Jonah	Respect God, build an alter to God, pray to God	<b>Jonah 3:7-9</b> – The pagans respond to God, not Jonah	Proclamation was issued to all of Nineveh.
<b>Jonah 1:15b</b> – God's response to the pagans	"...the raging sea grew calm"	<b>Jonah 3:10</b> – God's response to the pagans	"...God relented and did not bring on them the destruction he threatened."

<b>Jonah 2:</b> Jonah's conversation with God	"In my distress I called to the Lord, and he answered me"	<b>Jonah 4:</b> Jonah's conversation with God	Jonah prayed, "Isn't this what I said, Lord, when I was still at home?"
