Q4 Summary

- **Giving was \$1.02M**
 - Down \$23K when compared to prior year
- **Net Spending was \$749K**
 - Up \$15K when compared to prior year
- **Giving exceeded spending by \$270K**
 - In Q4 2024, giving exceeded spending by \$309K


YTD Summary

- **Giving was \$2.95M**
 - Up \$43K when compared to prior year
- **Net Spending was \$2.82M**
 - Down \$64K when compared to prior year
- **Giving exceeded spending by \$120K**
 - Through Q4 2024, giving exceeded spending by \$14K

Giving Trend

- For August - November, the monthly giving average was \$262K.
 - \$55K per month higher than the same period last year.
- December giving was \$527K, compared to \$618K from the prior year, which resulted in a similar giving pattern from 2024 to 2025 overall.

YTD Spending vs. Budget

- **Payroll Spend = \$1.38M**
 - Budgeted Payroll = \$1.60M
 - Favorable Variance = \$217K
- **Program Spend = \$1.44M**
 - Budgeted Program = \$1.55M
 - Favorable Variance = \$108K
- **Total Variance = \$325K less than Budget**




Giving History

YTD Giving




Net Spending History

Net Funds as of December 31

- **C&M Operating Reserves: \$489K**
- **Other Categories: \$976K**
 - Designated Funds (capital reserves, helping hand, etc.)
 - Short Term Missions
 - Bethesda/4-Plex/Warehouse
- **Total: \$1.47M**

Loan Details

Bethlehem Loan Details

- \$2.83M principal balance as of 12/31/2025
 - \$1.8M loan at interest rate of 3.2%, matures in Q4 of 2026.
 - \$1M Bethesda loan at interest rate of 8.23%
- YTD reduction in principal was \$112K

Financial Summary

- During 2025, giving exceeded spending by \$120K. The surplus was designated for debt reduction.
- Giving was up 1.5% from 2024.
- Program spending has increased compared to prior year but consistent with 2025 expectations.
- Operating cash reserves are above the 10% of the annual C&M budget.
