Keeper of the Keys

Our Lord challenges us to follow him in commitment and faithful service. We must not refuse him the key.

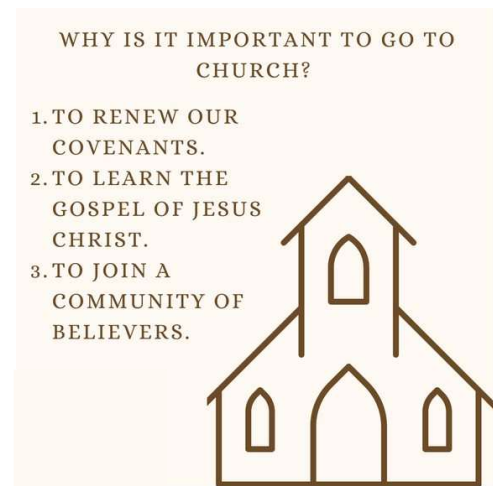


Renewal Day

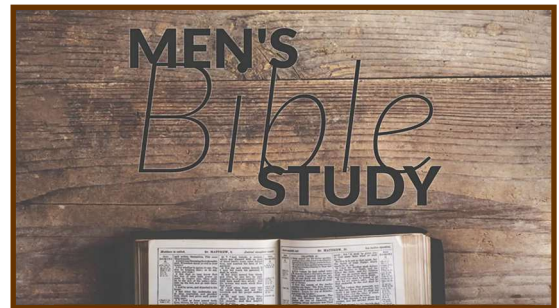

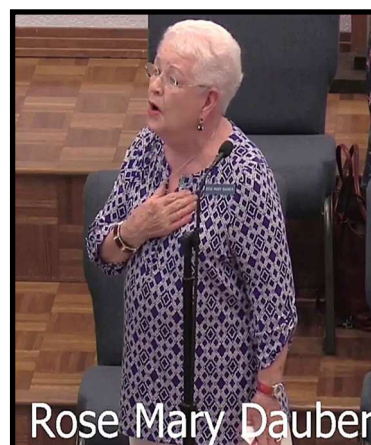
