CHBC MARRIAGE RETREAT


Friday, February 9th- 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. Saturday, February 10th-9 a.m.-12 p.m.

Wednesday, February 28th 5:30 p.m. Dinner 6 p.m. Race starts promptly


Cars will be for sale this Wednesday. You can purchase your car at check in. Cost is \$5. Our first night to work on cars will be February 7th.
