Imagine seeing the same landscape that Jesus saw, being baptized in the Jordan River, having a communion service at Golgotha, or singing at the Garden Tomb where the Lord was raised from the dead.

ITINERARY



DAY 1 - DEPART U.S.A.

Tour members will meet for the flight to Israel. On the flight, we will enjoy dinner and the on-board entertainment as we prepare to walk where Jesus walked in a land that uniquely contrasts modern life with the ancient world.

DAY 2 - SHALOM AND WELCOME TO ISRAEL!

Upon landing at Ben Gurion International Airport, we meet our guide and are escorted to the bus for a short drive to Netanya for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3 - CAESAREA, MT. CARMEL, DRUZE VILLAGE, CANA, NAZARETH, GALILEE

This morning we will depart for the Galilee, visiting Biblical sites at Caesarea (where Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Roman Centurion - Acts 10) and Mt. Carmel (where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal - 1 Kings 18). We drive through Cana (location of Jesus' first miracle - John 2). We'll stop at the Druze Village for lunch (included). We then continue to Nazareth (Jesus' childhood home) and visit the "Nazareth Village" with a detailed explanation of what life was like during the time of Jesus. and the Mt. of Precipice. We will then arrive in Tiberias for dinner and overnight on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 4 – GALILEE, MT. OF BEATITUDES, GOLAN HEIGHTS, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, TEL DAN, BOAT RIDE

Nothing beats watching the sun rise over the Sea of Galilee! We will begin today at the Mt. of Beatitudes where We will spend time reflecting and worshiping. Then we will travel north for the Golan Heights to view a beautiful landscape of northern Israel. We will head to the Mt. Bental overlook. From this former military base, we can look into Syria and learn about the village of Kunetra and the 1967 & 1973 Wars. Then we will head to Caesarea Philippi where Peter confessed "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16: 13-16). Nearby is the amazing nature preserve and archaeological site of Tel Dan. This is one of the sources of the Jordan River. We walk through this quiet national park and impressive Old Testament city and hear the stories of disobedience that took place here (Judges 18, 1 Kings 12). Our lunch stop (included) gives us the option of the special St. Peter's Fish for those interested. Next, we will board a replica wooden "Jesus Boat" to set sail on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight will be in Tiberias.

DAY 5 - MAGDALA, TABGHA, CAPERNAUM, GIDEON SPRINGS, JERUSALEM

After breakfast, we visit Magdala to see the recent excavations of a synagogue from the time of Jesus. Next, we will head to Tabgha (the traditional site of the feeding of the 5000) and the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter. We will make our way to Capernaum, Jesus' base for His early ministry, then stop for lunch (included). Time permitting, we will have a stop at Gideon Springs. We will then ascend to the majestic city of Jerusalem with a stop at Mt. Scopus. Dinner and overnight our hotel in Jerusalem. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem" (Psalm 122: 1-2 NASB).

DAY 6 – MT. OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE, BETHLEHEM

We begin the day on the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage proceeds down the Old Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, and the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We make our way to St. Stephen's Gate, to walk the Via Dolorosa – including St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pool of Bethesda, the Pavement (where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate), Ecce Homo Arch, and the ancient Cardo. We continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We conclude our sightseeing today with a visit to Bethlehem where we will also stop for lunch (included). We pass by Rachel's tomb on the outskirts, and visit the Church of the Nativity, Shepherd's Field, and the cave of Jerome. We will also have a visit to a local Baptist Church. Then we return to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7 – CITY OF DAVID, HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL, SOUTHERN STEPS, JEWISH QUARTER, RABBINICAL TUNNELS

This morning we drive to the incredible archaeological find, the City of David. Here we take a short walk to Hezekiah's Tunnel (conditions permitting). Be sure to bring a flashlight and good water shoes with you, as you will get wet walking through the tunnel. (Those who prefer to stay dry can walk through the shaft). If time permits, we will briefly visit the new excavations of the Pool of Siloam. Then we make our way to the Southern Steps, the archaeological reconstruction of the Temple Steps where Jesus walked so often.

After lunch (included) we will walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western (Wailing) Wall of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25). On this site now stands El-Aksa Mosque, and the magnificent Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in Islam). Then we walk along the Rabbi's Tunnel and come as close as is possible to the Holy of Holies. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 - YAD VASHEM, SHRINE OF THE BOOK, GARDEN TOMB

Today we will visit the city outside the walls. After breakfast, we will pass by the Supreme Court House, the Knesset (Israeli Parliament) and the famous Rose Garden on the way to the Yad Vashem Museum. This is the memorial to the victims of the Holocaust. After lunch (included), we will enjoy the world-renowned Israel Museum, recently renovated, and enhanced. It includes the Second Temple Model and the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed. We conclude the tour with communion at the Garden Tomb and return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 - QSAR EL-YAHUD (JORDAN RIVER), QUMRAN, EIN GEDI, MASADA, DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we drive to the Jordan River for an optional time of baptisms at the traditional site where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist at Qsar El-Yahud. Then we make our way to the Judean Wilderness. The road from Jerusalem to the Dead Sea region is a descent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. Our first stop will be at Qumran, the settlement of the first century sect known as the Essenes, authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Afterwards, a short drive takes us to Ein Gedi where David hid from King Saul. Then we will stop for lunch (included). From here we drive to Masada, where we will take a cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. Here we survey the ruins of fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples, and palaces. Dinner and overnight will be at the Dead Sea.

DAY 10 – LEISURE AT THE DEAD SEA, ELAH VALLEY, JAFFA, FAREWELL DINNER, BEN GURION AIRPORT

This morning we will have leisure time at the Dead Sea to enjoy floating in the water and the hotel spa (some services not included). After lunch (included), we depart the Dead Sea area and drive to the Elah Valley and the brook where David slew Goliath. From here, we continue to Jaffa for a tour at the flea market and special Farewell Dinner. We transfer to Ben Gurion airport for the flight back to the U.S.A. or for an O/N in Tel-Aviv, pending on flights.

DAY 11 – TRANSFER TO BEN GURION AIRPORT, ARRIVE BACK IN U.S.A.

We arrive back to the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Passports, visas, vaccinations (if required), laundry, lunches not on the tour menu (food outside of the contracted menu will be billed prior to leaving the hotel or restaurant), excursions not listed, telephone/international data, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, excess baggage fees, additional airline fees after registration, travel insurance, and all other items not explicitly mentioned.

PAYMENTS & FEES:
A deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$500 per person required within 21-days thereafter.
Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer; all payments are required in US Funds.

Final payment is due no later 120 days prior to departure.
Registrations after 120-days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90-days before departure. Failure to make final payment

by 90-days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees. imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as imagine) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (02/06/25).

GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:Tour pricing assumes a <u>minimum group size of 26 passengers</u>. **Smaller groups may incur supplements**:

\$120 per person (25-18 travelers) \$195 per person (17-14 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 14 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single rooms, when available, may be smaller and incur **an additional supplemental charge of \$1,395 for the basic itinerary**. Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single room occupancy may apply. Roommates may be assigned as late as 120-days prior to departure when

innagine reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120-days prior to departure.

All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee plus applicable airline

fees. All tours are made final at 90-days prior to departure. No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.

Land Only price is \$4,895 per person, excluding international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120-days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:

Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not imagine. imagine does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120-days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Due to group rates, imagine does not participate or allow passengers to use points, miles, or other airline-related offerings on group contracted airfare. Seating requests are at the discretion

of the applicable airline and cannot be guaranteed. All requests, including seating, dietary restrictions, and/or all other accommodation must be made in writing prior to 120-days of departure. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after 120-days prior to departure will incur additional fees. Individual ticketing fees may apply in certain situations. These fees can be up to \$2,000 per person and will be applied to your final balance.

All flight times are subject to change without notice. *imagine* is not liable for expenses resulting from flight delays or changes. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend obtaining a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24-hours prior to departure.

PASSPORTS & VISAS:

Passengers must ensure their passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120-days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. imagine is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.

imagine and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 121-days prior to departure <u>will be charged a \$500 administrative fee</u> plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, you may be charged their single room fee. 1
