- 1. Who is speaking in verse 1 and what is being said? In other words, from what you learned today what is meant in verse 1?
- 2. In verses 2-8 and from what you learned today, why does the wife delay when she hears her husband knocking at the door? How can you tell that some time has passed between verse 1 and verse 2?
- 3. Give some thought to how you were when you first got saved. How excited were you in your relationship with Christ? Were you ready to obey Him and spend time with Him? How about later in your Christian life, have you ever delayed in spending time with Him or slow in your obedience to Him?
- 4. In verses 9, the women ask the bride some questions. What do they ask? Why do you think it's important that they ask such questions?
- 5. In verses 10-16, the bride answers the women. Her response is detailed and quite lovely. Discuss her response and especially how she calls her husband her friend.
- 6. In John 15:13, Jesus said this: "Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends." This is the gospel. Jesus sacrificially took on our sins, died on the cross as our substitute, and was raised on the third day so that we could be His friend. The Bible tells us that before we are saved, we are His enemies, but God reconciled us to Himself through His death. Talk about this. Do you realize that before God saved you, you were His enemy? (Romans 5:10)
- Jesus also said this in the same chapter in John, verses 14-17: "You are My friends if you do what I command you. No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you. You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you. This I command you, that you love one another." Discuss the implications of these verses for you.
