- 2. Compare John 1:43 with John 2:2 and discuss the All-knowing (Omniscience) of God. Discuss the "opportunity" Jesus would have seen beforehand.
- 3. The disciples were "convenient" followers of Jesus at this time. Discuss the three levels of discipleship mentioned in the sermon.
- 4. What problems did the inadequacy of the wine supplied by the wedding party present for the family?
- 5. Discuss how Mary let Jesus know her concern.
- 6. What was meant by the term "My hour" that Jesus mentioned in vs. 4
- 7. While alcohol consumption among Christians is controversial today, how was Romans 14:13 and 21 used by the Pastor to encourage Christians to abstain from drinking?
- 8. Please read Isiaah 25:6-9 and discuss the intention of the work Jesus did...the abundance of the well-aged wine, should have validated what message?
