### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Take a moment and give willing members of your group an opportunity to share briefly, when "Jesus passed by" them and they trusted Him as their Savior.
- 2. How was John 9:2-5 used in the message to give attention to the "Unborn" being recognized as a person with the right to life?
- 3. What did God have to do in the man's brain at the same time Jesus healed his eyesight? What is the spiritual application of this? (See Romans 12:2)
- 4. The fact that this man had never seen anything before, made his "Coming back" to Jesus more interesting- Why? As a follow up, if this had been you, what would have been the top three things you would have wanted to see?
- 5. After anointing the man's eyes with a clay that He had made, what was the simple instruction (Charge) Christ gave to the man? How does this relate to the simplicity of being Bornagain?
- 6. Those who knew this man, previous to his receiving his sight, struggled with recognizing him. Describe the change they must have seen that led in their confusion. How is this like some who get saved today?
- 7. He stood boldly even though he did not fully understand who Jesus was until vs 38... how is this an inspiration for us to tell our story?
