- 1. Where is Jesus when news of Lazarus' illness reaches Him (Jn 10:40)? About how far away from Bethany was this?
- 2. What are the three answers to prayer that God usually gives, and which is the most difficult for you to hear? Why?
- 3. Read verse 4,15, and 42 from John 11, then answer- What was the reason(s) for Jesus delaying His journey to Bethany?
- 4. How does Hebrews 4:15 relate to Jesus' weeping in John 11:35? Discuss how this should be encouraging to us.
- How does the sorrow of a Christian differ from the sorrow of a person who is not in a relationship with Jesus? (See I Thess. 4:13)
- 6. Read aloud John 11:25 and discuss the meaning of this verse.
- 7. When Jesus called Lazarus forth, he came levitating to the door of the cave (Tomb)...what instructions did Jesus give to the people concerning him? How does this relate to the freedom we find in Christ?
- 8. How can one connect Ephesians 2:1-5 with the story of Lazarus?
- 9. In John 12:9-10 many believed on Jesus because they saw Lazarus...how can our living a resurrected life point people to Jesus?
