- 1. Who are the two Apostles mentioned in Acts 3:1, what time of day was it, and where were they going?
- 2. How old was the lame man? (Acts 4:22)
- 3. According to Acts 4:29-30 who actually did the signs and wonders?
- 4. In 1 Cor. 13:8 we read that some gifts will cease... discuss the need for transitory gifts, and why they would not longer be necessary once the Word of God had been given.
- 5. Read James 5:13-15 and discuss how God heals today.
- 6. The man who was healed prioritized praise and went directly into the Temple. How can the blessings of God sometimes result in taking us away from God, rather than draw us closer?
- 7. Read Isaiah 58:13-14. Although Sunday is the Lord's Day and not the Sabbath (7th day), the application can be made here. How would you explain this passage?
- 8. It was mentioned that a good motto for families would be "Fun Everyday, But Jesus First"... Discuss whether you agree or not.
- 9. According to Acts 4:4 how many men made professions of faith as a result of seeing this healed man praise the Lord? Discuss how people may come to Christ because of the change they see in us.
