- 3. Discuss the need for God's people to be aware of the Adversary's plan to destroy, and provide some suggestions as to how we can increase our awareness.
- 4. On a scale of 1 to 10, How difficult is it for you to share the Gospel with others? (10 being it is very difficult)
- 5. Discuss ways we can increase our boldness for Christ?
- 6. The key phrase in the book of Esther is "For such a time as this"... describe how this relates to our finding our purpose in life.
- 7. Looking back on your life, how has God used you? (Do you encourage others, do you seek to know and meet needs, do you tend to teach or instruct? How can this exercise help us determine God's purpose in our life?

- 9. What type of risk did Esther take in going in to the King to make intercession for her people? What risks do we take today when we choose to speak boldly for Jesus?
