## **Questions for D-Groups**

1. What is the significance of the Feast of Tabernacles.
  
2. The Children of Israel blamed Moses for their thirst. Do we blame others when things aren’t going as we planned? If yes, how can we change?
  
3. What was Moses and Aaron’s immediate response to the murmuring of the Israelites? (Num 20:6)
  
4. Moses got frustrated about the Israelites’ complaining, and it caused him to disobey God. How can you avoid making a similar mistake?
  
5. Did God still provide for His people even though Moses disobeyed His Word? Why do you think He did that?
  
6. What does God’s response to Moses teach us about how God values obedience to His Word? (Num 20:12)
  
7. Why did Jesus declare that He is the source of Living Water on the last day of the Feast of Tabernacles? Why did this statement on this day cause people to believe in Him?
  
8. How can we take advantage of the Living Water that only comes from knowing Jesus as our Savior?
  
9. Why is it important to recognize pictures of Christ in the Old Testament?
