CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS: (based on Col. 1:21ff)

- L: Once we were separated from God. The sinful things we did, the holy things we left undone, showed us for the people which we are by nature. But Christ has brought us back to God by dying in His body on the cross. He did this so that we could come into God's presence without sin, fault or blame.
- P: Almighty God, have mercy upon us, forgive us our sins, and lead us to everlasting life. Amen.
- L: God has made you alive with Christ. He forgives all your failures. He did this by erasing the charges that were brought against you. He took the charges away by nailing them to the cross of Jesus. In His name and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins. Amen.

FIRST READING: Colossians 1:21-29

Once you were separated from God. The evil things you did showed your hostile attitude. But now Christ has brought you back to God by dying in His physical body. He did this so that you could come into God's presence without sin, fault, or blame. This is on the condition that you continue in faith without being moved from the solid foundation of the hope that the Good News contains. You've heard this Good News of which I, Paul, became a servant. It has been spread throughout all creation under heaven.

I am happy to suffer for you now. In my body I am completing whatever remains of Christ's sufferings. I am doing this on behalf of His body, the church. I became a servant of the church when God gave me the work of telling you His entire message. In the past God hid this mystery, but now He has revealed it to His people. God wanted His people throughout the world to know the glorious riches of this mystery—which is Christ living in you, giving you the hope of glory.

CONFESSION OF FAITH: (based on Col. 1:15)

L: Jesus is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. He created all things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible. He is the head of the church which is His body and with the church on earth and in heaven we confess the faith once and for all delivered to the saints:

THE APOSTLES' CREED (*catholic means the universal Christian Church)

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary, He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. Holy Communion H

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Bethany in the joyful confession that our Lord gives us His very Body and Blood for the forgiveness of sins in this sacrament. God intends this gift for His children who recognize their sin, trust in Christ as their Savior, desire to live for Him alone and join in this joyful confession.

To help you prepare for communion we invite you to take a few moments of quiet prayer. For aid there are prayers on the front page of the hymnal for both before and after the reception of communion. Or simply pray, Dear Lord Jesus, at Your gracious invitation You invite me to come to You, to eat and drink Your holy body and blood as You Yourself have promised to give in this sacrament of Your altar. Forgive me of my sin, through this Your meal of Forgiveness. Let me experience the fullness of Your love, through this Your meal of love. Strengthen my faith, through this meal of Yours that calls for and bestows faith. Empower me to live for You, through this Your meal that promises life everlasting and equips me for daily living as one who has received You and Your gifts.

WORDS OF INSTITUTION

For those communing, who so desire, the center cups in each tray are <u>alcohol free</u>.

The wafers on the stand next to the pillar pulpit side (when kneeling for communion) or on the stand in front of the baptismal font (when processing for communion) are <u>gluten free</u>.

In our 9:30 am service, we will practice the Easter tradition of continuous communion. We will not kneel at the altar, rather we will join the procession of saints and come forward and remain standing as we receive the bread and wine. After receiving the elements, you are invited to return to your seat and continue in meditation, prayer and song.
