Gerving Passionately Ephesians 2:10

(Modates FROM KING OF NATIONS MINSTRIES

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at Bethany,

Thank you for your continued prayers and partnership in the ministry of King of the Nations Ministries (One King). We remain deeply grateful for the love, support. Your encouragement sustains us in the work of proclaiming Christ across cultures and borders. Prayer remains our foundation. We continue to host weekly gatherings of worship and intercession, both in person and online, and we are training indigenous pastors and leaders globally in how to lead prayer-centered disciple- making movements within their local communities. We truly believe that a praying church is a church aligned with the heart and mission of God. Local outreach is bearing fruit. Each Thursday evening, we gather with a group of Turkish Muslim friends at Christ Lutheran church in Costa Mesa to read Scripture and explore the story of God from Genesis onward. This has become a place of trust and friendship—where questions are welcomed, hearts are softening, and Christ is being gently and respectfully made known. We are also hosting ongoing hospitality and discussion gatherings at our ministry house in Buena Park, building bridges with both Arabic-speaking neighbors and friends. Training overseas continues to expand. Our second cohort of leaders in Southern India continues in our "Launching Prayer and Disciple-Making Movements" course, and this spring, we launched a new training cohort in Northern India. We are also preparing for a new potential partnership with pastors in Nepal who desire to train leaders for Gospel witness among their own communities. These leaders serve in challenging contexts, often with very limited resources—yet they display deep faith, joy, and hunger for the Word of God. We are honored to walk alongside them.

A Word from Rev. Dr. Richard Paul (One King Board Member): "What encourages me most about this ministry is that it consistently centers itself on Christ's mission to the nations—beginning here at home and extending to places many of us may never see in person, where they have little to no access to the Gospel. King of the Nations is not simply adding programs or events. It is forming disciples who pray, who love their neighbors, and who share the Gospel across cultural lines with humility and respect. In my observation, this ministry is bearing the kind of fruit that comes only through persistent prayer and a deep dependence on the Holy Spirit. I commend this work to your prayers and support."



NEWS FROM THE ODEMBA FAMILY SERVING IN KENYA

MISSION FORMATION TEAM The LCMS has launched Mission Formation teams to give people a hands-on introduction to mission service. These short-term groups are made up of individuals who feel called to explore serving overseas and want to learn more. Their time in the field allows them to see ministry up close and gain a realistic picture of what longterm mission work entails.

This past week, I had the privilege of leading the very first Mission Formation team for Africa here in Kenya. We visited several of our partner ministries, including the Lutheran seminary, three Project 24 sites, and a rural congregation out in the village. The team also joined in home visits with families in the communities of Kiriti and Kibera.

It was a meaningful week for everyone involved. The team got to experience the work firsthand—along with the travel, the food, the culture, and the warm hospitality of the Kenyan people. Our prayer is that God will continue to guide them, and if it is His will, stir in them a desire to serve overseas and be part of His mission in the world.

OLD STOMPING GROUNDS I recently had the joy of taking our Mission Formation team to the very first ministry I served with in Kenya. My work here began in 2013 at Karama Academy, in partnership with Springs of Life Lutheran Church in Kibera. Serving in Africa's largest informal settlement came with its challenges, but I was blessed with a wonderful team of local teachers who encouraged me, taught me new ways to care for our students, and helped shape my early years in mission work. I'm still so grateful for that season and all I learned from them. While my work has since shifted to other ministries and I don't visit Karama as often, every time I return I'm reminded of how far the school has come since those early days. It's always a joy to see the growth and the impact God continues to bring through this ministry.

Thank you for your love and support over the years. We are thankful for each and every one of you. May God continue to bless you and keep you.




