Music Academy Enrollment Information, Fees & Policies

FEES & POLICIES:

Each student in the Music Academy will pay Tuition which is \$350.00 per semester (for 12 scheduled private lessons—30 minutes in length). Students who wish to take longer lessons (45 minutes) will be assessed additional Tuition fees. Tuition must be paid by the first lesson; families who wish to break up the payment into two equal installments, please speak directly with Music Academy Administrator. If paying in two equal installments, the first half (\$175) of Tuition is due at the first lesson and the remaining half of Tuition (\$175) is due by the sixth lesson.

There are no refunds or make-up lessons for any missed lessons on the student's part. A student should attend their lesson even if his/her class materials are forgotten at home. If the instructor is unable to keep a scheduled lesson, then a make-up lesson will be arranged. Any missed make up lessons are forfeited, and no additional make-up opportunity will be given. There will be lessons scheduled on Parent Teacher Conference days and some of our school half-days; please make every effort to honor these scheduled lessons.

Should a situation require that a student withdraw, please inform the Academy Administrator and the instructor. Refunds cannot be made because time is reserved and instructors are hired on a semester basis. Checks returned by the bank for Non-Sufficient Funds will be assessed an additional \$75 fee. Past due accounts may result in suspension of lessons, non-participation in the recital, and/or barring from future enrollment in the Music Academy. Exceptions to the above may be made by the Academy Administrator.

FORMS:

Enrollment Forms are available in the school or church office or may be found on the church's website: www.bethanylutheran.org Enrollment Forms must be filled out completely & signed; make sure to indicate which day works best with your calendar. Please return forms to the church or school office no later than January 22. It is impossible to schedule every student in a 3:15 lesson slot; priority is given to students who continue from Fall to Spring semester lessons. Spring semester lessons will begin the week of January 27.

Full and partial scholarships may be available. Please speak with or email the Academy Administrator for more information. Requests are based on financial need and/or as funds become available. All requests are kept strictly confidential.
