Arthur was able to attend the symposia and his graduation in May. Demetrio and his wife Nuria, who is also studying to be a deaconess, recently returned to Panama to continue their service here. Please join us in giving thanks for these faithful servants of God.

The past few months have been filled with so many blessings as we continue to work on replanting our congregation in Balboa. Easter was a joyous occasion celebrating the resurrection of our Lord as we joined together for worship and fellowship including breakfast, an egg hunt and other activities for the children. Our greatest joys were reconnecting with some members who live further away and can't attend regularly and welcoming a precious baby girl into God's family through the waters of Holy Baptism. Arthur has had the privilege of baptizing three more little ones over the past few months. He has also been meeting regularly with a young man for adult instruction / catechesis studying not just Luther's Small Catechism, but also the Large Catechism and other parts of the Book of Concord.

Eva continues working with the ladies in Spain and Panama finishing up this academic year with a course on mercy and the second trimester of the diaconal practicum. She also continues serving throughout the region and is currently preparing the fall practicum for the deaconesses. In June, Redeemer also helped host a workshop on reconciliation in conjunction with the Mercy Center and Seminary in the Dominican Republic. Church workers and lay members were invited from all the congregations, and it also served as a continuing education course for the deaconesses and deaconess students.
