## Letters from Latin America

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

*"And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth." John 1:5 ESV*

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! As we enter this holy season of Advent and prepare to celebrate the birth of our Savior, we give thanks to God for you and for your faithful partnership in the Gospel. Advent reminds us that God keeps His promises. In Christ, God comes near, entering our world with mercy, forgiveness, and hope. Even amid challenges and busy preparations, we rejoice that the Lord is at work among His people here in Panama.

We recently marked the beginning of the new Church Year with a joyful celebration involving the children of the congregation. Together, they helped decorate the Christmas tree in the church and set up the Advent Wreath. It is a simple but meaningful way to teach them that Advent is a season of waiting, hope, and joy in Christ as we light the Advent candles each week.

The following week, we celebrated Mother's Day (December 8th in Panama), giving thanks for the women God has placed in our families and congregation. It was a beautiful opportunity to honor their love, service, and faithfulness, and to rejoice together as the family of God.

Our congregation is now preparing for our Christmas concert and Christmas services. Rehearsals are underway and hearts are being prepared to hear once again the Good News of Christ's birth. We look forward to welcoming members and visitors to hear the Gospel proclaimed in Word and song.

We are thankful to share that the second deaconess class of the year began during the first week of December. The ladies are now studying the Catechism. Please keep these women in your prayers as they continue their formation to serve Christ's people with mercy and faithfulness.

This month also brought an unexpected challenge. There was a water-main break that resulted in a large hole in the church courtyard between the sanctuary and the fellowship hall as the city workers tried to assess the situation and make repairs. While this was certainly not planned, we are thankful for God's protection and for the patience as we wait for repairs to be completed. Even these interruptions remind us that the Church is not built on bricks and mortar, but on Christ Himself.
