

MARCH 2 & 3 I AM THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

SPEAKER: DR. DONN S. CHAPMAN SENIOR PASTOR

Jesus declared, "I Am." In the world, nothing holds greater significance than understanding who Jesus is and what he came to do. Within the Gospel of John, seven "I Am" statements provide insight some comparative, others declarative—helping us better understand Jesus and his mission.

He compared himself to bread and light, the essentials for life, to emphasize how he is essential to spiritual life. Speaking in cultural phrases, Jesus portrays himself as both the door to the sheepfold

and the good shepherd. He boldly proclaims to be the resurrection and the life, the way, the truth, and the life—the exclusive path to heaven. Lastly, he uses a grapevine metaphor to illustrate how he meets our needs as we live in fellowship with him.

As we learn through this series, I believe our relationship with Jesus will deepen, revealing his unparalleled nature. And then, we will love him even more.

(Philippians 3:10a NLT)
