THIS IS THE THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

Today I am recovering from hip surgery; mostly staying at home. Our children are taking turns as caregiver 24/7. As I sipped my morning coffee I read the assigned

Gospel verses, and opened my "Christ in My Home" booklet. I was suddenly faced with a concept that had not before occurred to me and which I don't remember ever hearing preached. Or else I dosed off at that point of the sermon. Forgive me Pastor Manuel.

Today's reading is from John's Gospel, the 21st chapter. Pastor Elena reminded us that it seems like a story that John realized was missing and he added it later. After years of traveling with Jesus; hearing him teach, watching him heal and raise people from death, and then seeing him crucified and resurrected, some of the disciples returned to what they had been doing before Jesus called them; fishing on the Sea of Tiberius. Were they going to return to their former lives and forget about their three -year experience so near to the Kingdom of God? Did they forget that they had a story to tell?

In vs. 15-17 Jesus tells Simon Peter to, "Feed my lambs," "Tend my sheep," and "Feed my sheep." I had never thought of Jesus' charge to Peter as more than an abstract theme. But Jesus really meant it. He was directing Peter and the others to transform their lives and leave their former trades behind. After this we hear no more stories about any of the 11 disciples going back to what they did before Jesus called them. They got Jesus' message and told the story as he directed them in; Matt 28:19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."



Are we to abandon our careers in order to share Jesus' message? Saul/Paul did. We are told that many of the disciples did. Some people do so today. Pastor Manuel and Pastor Elena did.

The more important thing for us is that we; you and me, must continue to tell Jesus' story wherever and whenever we can. Bill Fredericks

UPDATE ON DEFERRED MAINTENANCE PROJECTS

STAINED GLASS

We had to remove the "west-is" facing horizontal stained glass windows above the Narthex and office before we could re-roof. These windows did not have a protective eave, and this is the direction the winds blow from most frequently, and also receive the most sun. They were so badly cracked the roof bidders either backed out or would not warranty the roof until we removed or fixed them. We found a company that works on rare Dalle de Verre stained glass, and they removed these five windows (15 of the 99 panes of stained glass windows in the church). One of these windows was no longer visible, it was covered by the organ installed in 2014, so it is being stored in the basement for now. The place where that window was has been blocked and stuccoed. The other 775 pounds of window were shipped out for repair.

The stained-glass company called last week, and said they have the glass for the four windows faceted and ready to be placed in the pouring frames, except for

the blue color. The blue they ordered turned out to be much more opaque and darker than the original color and wanted to know if we wanted the windows sooner, or willing to wait another two to three months so they could source a bet-



ter match. Since the blue is the primary color in those windows, I'd said we would wait. The repair costs are about \$6,000/per pane, so stained glass repair is a long, long-term project.

ALL are invited to attend the *Gather* Bible Study on Monday, June 9 at 11:00 a.m. Pastor Manuel will lead the Bible study.


<u>READERS - - (EYEGLASSES)</u>




Comparison of years 2023, 2024, 2025


