MINISTRY FUNDING UPDATE

Results as of 6/30/2024

YTD RECEIPTS: \$749,950

Receipts are lower than our plan by \$90,400.

YTD EXPENSES: \$803,773

Year over year timing has us \$36,157 below plan.

NUMBERS THROUGH JUNE 30

CGLC giving is up \$77,626 in 2024 compared to 2023 but is still behind our YTD Ministry Funding Plan (MFP) of \$840,340. We continue to manage our expenses and are currently \$36,157 below our YTD MFP expenses of \$839,930. This is great news, but history suggests our expenses will catch up to plan in the last half of the year. Thank you for your continued support of CGLC and funding our ministry.



LET'S CELEBRATE SOUND AMP UP CAMPAIGN IS A SUCCESS

Thank you for your generous support of our campaign to fund the new sound system in the Sanctuary. We surpassed our goal reaching \$71,016. The final installation work gets underway in mid August.
