Where have we been, where are we now, and where are we going? All questions that come to mind as we begin 2025.

We are 18 months into a journey that began in 2023 to listen, learn, and discern what God has for us in the next chapter of life at Community of Grace.

As we completed some surveys, conducted interviews, gathered thoughts from our Family Meeting, and leaned into prayer, several things emerged as "guideposts" of understanding.

We heard that our congregation is healthy and happy and that we desire a greater missional impact in our broader community. We learned that our people value our Christian Schools, our Lutheran heritage, and our variety of worship options but are concerned about our lack of younger families and the limitations of our facilities.

We discerned through prayer that our congregation desires to be led by the Holy Spirit in our decisionmaking, encouraged to interact with our neighbors in a nonjudgmental way, focused on Jesus in all we say and do, and trusting in God's timing and provision for the plan he will reveal to us.

Today, we are actively engaging in conversations and actions to bring unity on our campus with our ministry partners—especially our K-8 school that will be changing its name to Community of Grace



Christian School to better reflect our shared history and our future missional partnership.

We are pursuing our mutual commitment to understand the felt needs of our neighborhood so we can position ourselves to meet those needs through our members and our facilities. We are moving forward under a banner of Grace Together because our combined energy and resources are multiplied when we Know, Trust, Imitate, and Speak Jesus and See, Love, Serve, and Teach people the way Jesus does.

I hope and trust that, by this time next year, we will have clarity around all that God is asking of our Grace Together Project, and that we will be launching ahead into a bold vision for the future of our campus and its ministries.

Hear our prayers, Lord Jesus, and lead us forward, Holy Spirit!



VALUES FOR MINISTRY & MISSION

CGLC leadership introduced our congregation to our new values for ministry and mission last fall when we kicked off our Spirit of Grace sermon series. The discernment of values resulted in what we now call our Missional Narrative:

Community of Grace Ministries embraces the undeniable truth that God loves and values all people—no exceptions. This truth is manifested clearly in the person of Jesus, who modeled unconditional, boundless love. There are no outsiders to Jesus' love, no us versus them, only people God seeks to invite into his family. This is Grace!

Convicted by this Holy Purpose and empowered by the Holy Spirit, we are aligned to four core value statements that drive our actions and decisions: We will see people the way Jesus sees people

We will love people the way Jesus loves people

We will serve people the way Jesus serves people

We will teach people the way Jesus teaches people

This is our Holy Calling: to follow Jesus as a community of his Grace, and to help others know Jesus through us.

In order to act effectively on this narrative, we need to become more like Jesus. The building blocks for our personal transformation are what we call our **Formational Values:**

Know Jesus, Trust Jesus, Imitate Jesus, and Speak Jesus.
