HELLO

ALL IN GOD'S TIME by Senior Pastor Darrin Vick

Last fall, I introduced you to a new set of formational and missional values for our congregation. As a preaching team, we took time to reveal these values and speak about them as an important foundation for the future ministry of Community of Grace and our ministry partners. Our teaching about these new values has brought up some very common questions. "Was something wrong with our old values?" "Have we changed what we believe as a congregation?" I want to answer these because I appreciate them!

First, there was nothing wrong with our old values. On the contrary, they have been very helpful in articulating our beliefs and clarifying our theology over the past ten years. That also helps answer the second guestion. No, we are not changing our beliefs or our theology. But here's the thing: our beliefs and theology are different from what we value. For example, I believe that speeding is dangerous and against the law. But sometimes, I still exceed the speed limit. Why? Because it is very easy for human beings to disconnect belief from behavior. While what we say we believe is important, our behavior reveals what we actually value.

Let me be specific. We believe that "Jesus makes us family." This is beautiful and true. But how does this family behave toward one another and the community around us? That's where our values come into play. We will see people the way Jesus sees people. We will love people the way Jesus loves people.

We will serve people the way Jesus serves people. We will teach people the way Jesus teaches people. Jesus has invited us to be a part of this kind of family. These values help us know when we are living like Jesus' family and when we are missing the mark.

So how do these values become a greater and more significant part of how we do family life together? By following Jesus together. As we follow him, we will begin to know Jesus, trust Jesus, imitate Jesus, and speak Jesus. This is the definition of being a disciple of Jesus. It is a process of spiritual formation where we become a community of disciples on a mission of grace.

Our previous value statements will remain on our website because they are a wonderful explanation of what we believe as a congregation. Expect to see our new value statements (along with our missional narrative) displayed creatively around our building in the months ahead.


