I try to stay off social media these days because I find so little of it to be edifying. But every once in a while I come across a quote that catches my eye and shifts my perspective. This is a recent example of just such a quote:

"'The times are bad! The times are troublesome!' This is what humans say. But we are our times. Let us live well and our times will be good. Such as we are, such are our times." - Saint Augustine

Saint Augustine of Hippo lived his life in the shadow of a dying empire - The Roman Empire. It would have been easy to fall into despair as was the case for many of Augustine's contemporaries. For all its faults, the Roman Empire had provided a sense of security and stability for centuries. To witness its demise would have been demoralizing even to the most optimistic of people.

But Augustine didn't place his hope in Caesar or his empire, even though he benefitted from the protection it provided. No matter how bad and troublesome the times appeared, Augustine refused to succumb to hopelessness, nor did he try to distance himself from the reality of pain and suffering that he witnessed. Rather, he saw himself as part of an eternal Kingdom - The City of God. In this Kingdom, power comes through suffering, and victory comes through the cross of Jesus Christ.




9 a.m. | Begins in Worship



MINISTRY FUNDING UPDATE

Results as of 9/30/2025

YTD RECEIPTS: \$1,077,994

Receipts are lower than our plan by \$231,056.

YTD EXPENSES: \$1,283,173

We are currently \$25,127 below plan.

NUMBERS THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30

CGLC giving is down \$6,200 in 2025, compared to 2024 - and is well below our YTD Ministry Funding Plan (MFP) of \$1,309,050. We continue to manage our expenses, and are expecting to end the year just under our MFP expense budget. Our receipts are currently \$205,179 less than our actual

YTD expenses. Please consider an additional gift to help us finish the year, fully funding our ministry here at CGLC. Thank you for all of your ongoing support!
