Facilities – reported by Mike Hamernick on behalf of Mike Mathisen

There is a storage shed/fencing project that will take place this fall. The three primary reasons for this project are:

- Significantly improve the safety of the playground and eliminate blind or "hiding" spots
- The current sheds are in need of significant repairs that we estimate to be about \$5,000
- Increase the amount of storage and consolidate it into one building that is located on the current blacktop parking lot
 - o Space goes from 200 sq ft to 288 sq ft

The new storage building will be located just to the east of the current garbage dumpsters. We will then remove and dispose of the old sheds and repair, revise, and add the new fencing to resecure and make the playground a safer environment. The last piece of the project is to install a new wood privacy fence

to screen the dumpster area from view. This is a city compliance issue that we have been avoiding but needs to be completed.

The total estimated cost is approximately \$30,000 for the entire project. The plan is to fund this from a designated gift that was given to cover a special project when identified.

The council approved a motion to spend up to \$30,000 for the project, to come from dedicated funds that can be used for the project.
