PRACTICING THE WAY & GRACE TOGETHER

Author Matthew Kelly once said, "Most people overestimate what they can do in a day, and underestimate what they can do in a month. We overestimate what we can do in a year, and underestimate what we can accomplish in a decade."

I have witnessed this truism on many occasions in my personal life and ministry. Perhaps it is my personality. I love to dive into new projects and get things started but sometimes my enthusiasm wanes as the early excitement shifts into a long-term grind. It is challenging when you are hoping and expecting immediate results but, instead, progress becomes a slow road with many hills to climb and valleys to endure. Not to mention the unexpected detours that become dead ends requiring you double-back and return to your previous path.

Was that time wasted? Can you make up for it by moving faster? I have asked these questions many times. Whether it was starting a fitness journey, breaking an old habit, learning a new skill, or envisioning a preferred future - the struggle is real, and being shortsighted gets in the way of having a long view.

Two specific things come to mind when I think of our current journey as a congregation. The first is our new focus on spiritual formation through Practicing the Way. Having completed the eight-week course with our staff, I am keenly aware

that eight weeks is just enough time to introduce some spiritual practices - and totally inadequate to make any of them a habit. That was my experience. Maybe it will be different for you. But something as important as following the way of Jesus requires a different perspective on time and progress. We need an outlook of months and years, not days and weeks.

Which brings me to my second point - Grace Together. When we began this campus-wide exploration of strategic alignment for the sake of future ministry and facility expansion, I didn't realize how long it would take. Bringing diverse organizations with unique cultures together into a unified, missional vision is exciting, but it is also difficult (and sometimes tedious) work. I probably overestimated what we could accomplish in a year or two. But I am committed to listening, learning, and discovering what God desires for this campus - five, ten, or even twenty years into the future. It's a long view.



YTD RECEIPTS: \$935,629

Receipts are lower than our plan by \$227,971.

YTD EXPENSES: \$1,143,395

We are currently \$19,538 below plan.

NUMBERS THROUGH AUGUST 31

CGLC giving is down \$38,045 in 2025, compared to 2024 - and is well below our YTD Ministry Funding Plan (MFP) of \$1,163,600. We continue to manage our expenses, and are currently \$19,538 below our YTD MFP expense plan. We are expecting to end the year just
