

MINISTRY FUNDING UPDATE

Preliminary results as of 4/30/2024

YTD RECEIPTS: \$514,092

Receipts are lower than our plan by \$46,141.

YTD EXPENSES: \$510,200

Year over year timing has us \$49,753 below plan.

PRELIMINARY NUMBERS THROUGH APRIL 30

CGLC giving is up \$30,544 in 2024 compared to 2023 but is still behind our Ministry Funding Plan (MFP) of \$560,233. We continue to manage our expenses and are currently \$49,753 below our MFP expenses of \$559,953.

This is great news, but history suggests our expenses will catch up to plan in the last half of the year. Thank you for your continued support of CGLC Ministry Funding.

In addition, School Tools filled another 117 bags for students overseas—part of the missions work accomplished by *Women of Grace*. CGLC Circle members work diligently to support Lutheran World Relief efforts.
