A SEASON OF RENEWAL

I'm grateful to share some exciting news about a season of renewal ahead. In 2026, after 25 years of ministry, I will be taking my first pastoral sabbatical. Even more meaningful, Community of Grace has been awarded the Clergy Renewal Program Grant through the Lilly Foundation, which will generously support this time away for rest, learning, and spiritual refreshment.

The idea of sabbatical is rooted deeply in Scripture and in the historic rhythms of the Church. Just as God called His people to seasons of Sabbath rest (as we have been learning in "Practicing the Way"), the Church has long encouraged pastors to step away periodically for renewal, reflection, and growth. In recent decades, sabbaticals have become a vital practice for sustaining long-term, healthy ministry. They help pastors return with renewed energy and creativity, and they bless congregations by strengthening leadership for the years ahead.

This sabbatical is significant not only because it is my first, but also because it marks an important milestone for Community of Grace: this is the first time a Senior Pastor in our congregation has been granted a sabbatical. I am deeply thankful for the support of our Church Council and the trust vou have placed in our shared ministry.






MINISTRY FUNDING UPDATE

Results as of 10/31/2025

YTD RECEIPTS: \$1,168,429

Receipts are lower than our plan by \$286,071.

YTD EXPENSES: \$1,428,223

We are currently \$25,444 below plan.

NUMBERS THROUGH OCTOBER 31

CGLC giving is down \$11,842 in 2025, compared to 2024 - and is well below our YTD Ministry Funding Plan (MFP) of \$1,454,500. We continue to manage our expenses, and are expecting to end the year just under our MFP expense budget. Our receipts are currently \$259,794 less than our actual YTD



expenses. Through Sunday, 11/23/25, we are projecting that we need \$425,000 in giving by the end of this year to fully fund our ministry here at CGLC. Please consider giving an additional year-end gift to help us finish strong, positioning us well for our 2026 ministry year. Thank you in advance, and God bless you!

BEGINS SUNDAY NOVEMBER 30


