# ...again! 2026

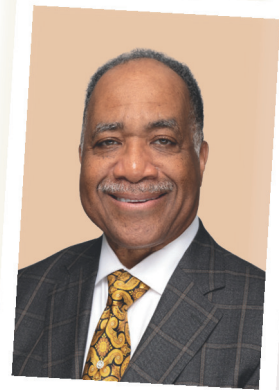


"And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart. And I will be found of you, saith the LORD"
