1. Worship which (most) delights the heart of God is not always logical, but it is always from the heart (Mark 14:1–9; especially verse 6 “kalos” – “beautiful” worship).
2. Worship which (most) delights the heart of God is often sacrificial. Mary empties the entire alabaster jar of perfume on Jesus’ head and feet (Mark 14:1–9; John 12).
3. Worship which (most) delights the heart of God often includes our: time, talents, treasures, priorities and even bowing our pride for God’s glory (Mary “washing” Jesus’ feet with her hair - John 12; Mark 14:1–9).
