Exodus 15:24 (NLT) Then the people complained and turned against Moses. "What are we going to drink?" they demanded.

Exodus 15:26 (NLT) He said, "If you will listen carefully to the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in his sight, obeying his commands and keeping all his decrees, then I will not make you suffer any of the diseases I sent on the Egyptians; for I am the Lord who heals you."

Exodus 19:4–6 (NLT) ⁴ 'You have seen what I did to the Egyptians. You know how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. ⁵ Now if you will obey me and keep my covenant, you will be my own special treasure from among all the peoples on earth; for all the earth belongs to me. ⁶ And you will be my kingdom of priests, my holy nation.' This is the message you must give to the people of Israel."

Exodus 25:8–9 (NLT) ⁸ "Have the people of Israel build me a holy sanctuary so I can live among them. ⁹ You must build this Tabernacle and its furnishings exactly according to the pattern I will show you.

For your presence among us sets your people and me apart from all other people on the earth." ¹⁷ The Lord replied to Moses, "I will indeed do what you have asked, for I look favorably on you, and I know you by name."

Numbers 14:8–9 (NLT) ⁸ And if the Lord is pleased with us, he will bring us safely into that land and give it to us. It is a rich land flowing with milk and honey. ⁹ Do not rebel against the Lord, and don't be afraid of the people of the land. They are only helpless prey to us! They have no protection, but the Lord is with us! Don't be afraid of them!"
