Acts 15:28 (NLT) For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us to lay no greater burden on you than these few requirements:

As a child of God, how well do you know His voice?

Acts 8:26 (NKJV) Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, "Arise and go toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." This is desert.

Acts 8:27–28 (NKJV) ²⁷ So he arose and went. And behold, a man of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of the Ethiopians, who had charge of all her treasury, and had come to Jerusalem to worship, ²⁸ was returning. And sitting in his chariot, he was reading Isaiah the prophet.

Acts 8:29–31 (NKJV) ²⁹ Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot." ³⁰ So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?" ³¹ And he said, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" And he asked Philip to come up and sit with him.

Acts 8:38–40 (NKJV) ³⁸ So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him. ³⁹ Now when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught Philip away, so that the eunuch saw him no more; and he went on his way rejoicing. ⁴⁰ But Philip was found at Azotus. And passing through, he preached in all the cities till he came to Caesarea.

Acts 10:9–16 (NKJV) ⁹ The next day, as they went on their journey and drew near the city, Peter went up on the housetop to pray, about the sixth hour. ¹⁰ Then he became very hungry and wanted to eat; but while they made ready, he fell into a trance ¹¹ and saw heaven opened and an object like a great sheet bound at the four corners, descending to him and let down to the earth. ¹² In it were all kinds of four-footed animals of the earth, wild beasts, creeping things, and birds of the air. ¹³ And a voice came to him, "Rise, Peter; kill and eat." ¹⁴ But Peter said, "Not so, Lord! For I have never eaten anything common or unclean." ¹⁵ And a voice *spoke* to him again the second time, "What God has cleansed you must not call common." ¹⁶ This was done three times. And the object was taken up into heaven again.

Acts 10:17–20 (NKJV) ¹⁷ Now while Peter wondered within himself what this vision which he had seen meant, behold, the men who had been sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate. ¹⁸ And they called and asked whether Simon, whose surname was Peter, was lodging there. ¹⁹ While Peter thought about the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, three men are seeking you. ²⁰ Arise therefore, go down and go with them, doubting nothing; for I have sent them."

John 16:7–11 (NKJV) ⁷ Nevertheless I tell you the truth. **It is to your advantage that I go away**; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. ⁸ And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: ⁹ of sin, because they do not believe in Me; ¹⁰ of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; ¹¹ of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

John 16:12–16 (NKJV) ¹² "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. ¹³ However, when He, the **Spirit of truth**, has come, **He will guide you** into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears **He will speak**; and **He will tell you things to come**. ¹⁴ He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and **declare** *it* **to you**. ¹⁵ All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and **declare** *it* **to you**. ¹⁶ "A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me, because I go to the Father."

Romans 8:26–27 (NKJV) ²⁶ Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. ²⁷ Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit *is*, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

Developing a relationship with the Holy Spirit will not diminish your relationship with the Father or with Jesus. Rather, it enhances it.

You will never learn the leading of the Holy Spirit without praying and seeking God's direction in your life . . . continually.

Galatians 5:18(NKJV) But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

Galatians 5:25(NKJV) If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Ephesians 5:18(NKJV) And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,

Acts 17:28(NKJV) for in Him we live and move and have our being. . .

Jeremiah 33:3(NKJV) 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

John 10:27–30 (NKJV) ²⁷ My sheep **hear** My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. ²⁸ And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. ²⁹ My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father's hand. ³⁰ I and *My* Father are one."

Galatians 5:25 (NLT) Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives.
