

**Psalm 63:4 (NKJV)** Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name.

**Psalm 134:2 (NKJV)** Lift up your hands *in* the sanctuary, And bless the LORD.

**Psalm 141:2 (NKJV)** Let my prayer be set before You *as* incense, The lifting up of my hands *as* the evening sacrifice.

**1 Timothy 2:8 (NKJV)** I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting;

**Isaiah 29:13 (NIV)** The Lord says: "These people come near to me with their mouth and honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. Their worship of me is made up only of rules taught by men.

**Matthew 25:34-36 (NKJV)** <sup>34</sup> Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: <sup>35</sup> for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; <sup>36</sup> I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.'

**Matthew 25:37-40 (NKJV)** <sup>37</sup> Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed *You*, or thirsty and give *You* drink? <sup>38</sup> When did we see You a stranger and take *You* in, or naked and clothe *You*? <sup>39</sup> Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to *You*?' <sup>40</sup> And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did *it* to one of the least of these My brethren, you did *it* to Me.'

**Matthew 25:45-46 (NKJV)** <sup>45</sup> . . . . . 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do *it* to one of the least of these, you did **not** do *it* to Me.' <sup>46</sup> And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

**Psalm 23:6 (NKJV)** Surely goodness **and** mercy **shall** follow me **all** the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the LORD Forever.

**Psalm 113:1-4 (NKJV)** <sup>1</sup> Praise the LORD! Praise, O servants of the LORD, Praise the name of the LORD! <sup>2</sup> Blessed be the name of the LORD From this time forth and forevermore! <sup>3</sup> From the rising of the sun to its going down The LORD'S name *is* to be praised. <sup>4</sup> The LORD *is* high above all nations, His glory above the heavens.

**Psalm 50:23 (NLT)** <sup>23</sup> But giving thanks is a sacrifice that truly honors me. If you keep to my path, I will reveal to you the salvation of God."

**Jeremiah 33:11 (NKJV)** the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "Praise the LORD of hosts, For the LORD *is* good, For His mercy *endures* forever"-- *and* of those *who will* bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD . . .

**Psalm 95:6 (NKJV)** Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel (Barak) before the LORD our Maker.

**Psalm 34:1 (NKJV)** I will bless (Barak) the LORD at all times; His praise *shall* continually *be* in my mouth.

**Psalm 145:4 (NKJV)** One generation shall praise (Shabach) Your works to another, And shall declare Your mighty acts.

**Isaiah 12:6 (NKJV)** Cry out and shout, (Shabach) O inhabitant of Zion, For great *is* the Holy One of Israel in your midst!"

**Psalm 21:13 (NKJV)** Be exalted, O LORD, in Your own strength! We will sing and praise (Zamar) Your power.

**Psalm 57:8-9 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> Wake up, my heart! Wake up, O lyre and harp! I will wake the dawn with my song. <sup>9</sup> I will thank you, Lord, among all the people. I will sing your praises (Zamar) among the nations.

**Psalm 71:22 (NLT)** Then I will praise you with music on the harp, because you are faithful to your promises, O my God. I will sing praises to you with a lyre, O Holy One of Israel.

**Psalm 22:3 (KJV)** But thou *art* holy, *O thou* that inhabits the praises of Israel.

**Zephaniah 3:17 (NLT)**

<sup>17</sup> For the Lord your God is living among you.

He is a mighty savior.

He will take delight in you with gladness.

With his love, he will calm all your fears.

He will rejoice over you with joyful songs.”
