

Are you speaking with such a heavenly accent that people wonder where you're from?

**John 13:34–35 (NKJV)** <sup>34</sup> A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. <sup>35</sup> **By this all will know that you are My disciples**, if you have love for one another.

**John 15:12–13,17 (NKJV)** <sup>12</sup> This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. <sup>13</sup> Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. <sup>17</sup> These things I command you, that you love one another.

**John 15:17–19 (NKJV)** <sup>17</sup> These things I command you, that you **love** one another. <sup>18</sup> "If the world **hates** you, you know that it hated Me before *it hated* you. <sup>19</sup> If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

**John 15:19 (NKJV)** If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet **because you are not of the world**, but I chose you out of the world, **therefore** the world hates you.

**John 15:25 (NLT)** This fulfills what is written in their Scriptures: 'They hated me without cause.'

**John 15:26–27 (NLT)** <sup>26</sup> "But I will send you the Advocate—the Spirit of truth. He will come to you from the Father and will testify all about me. <sup>27</sup> And you must also testify about me because you have been with me from the beginning of my ministry.

By speaking the truth in love as we are led by the Holy Spirit

**John 16:1 (NLT)** I have told you these things so that you won't abandon your faith.

**John 6:68–69 (NLT)** <sup>68</sup> Simon Peter replied, "Lord, to whom would we go? You have the words that give eternal life. <sup>69</sup> We believe, and we know you are the Holy One of God."

**John 16:33 (NLT)** I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world.”

**John 16:1–3 (NLT)** “I have told you these things so that you won’t abandon your faith. <sup>2</sup> For you will be expelled from the synagogues, and the time is coming when those who kill you will think they are doing a holy service for God. <sup>3</sup> This is because they have never known the Father or me.

**John 16:5–6 (NLT)** <sup>5</sup> “But now I am going away to the one who sent me, and not one of you is asking where I am going. <sup>6</sup> Instead, you grieve because of what I’ve told you.

**John 16:7 (NLT)** But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don’t, the Advocate won’t come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you.

**John 16:8–10 (NLT)** <sup>8</sup> And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God’s righteousness, and of the coming judgment. <sup>9</sup> The world’s sin is that it refuses to believe in me. <sup>10</sup> Righteousness is available because I go to the Father, and you will see me no more.

**John 16:8 (NLT)** And when he comes, **he will convict the world of its sin**, and of God’s righteousness, and of the coming judgment.

**1 Corinthians 6:11 (NKJV)** And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

**John 16:9 (NLT)** The world’s sin is that it refuses to believe in me.

The world’s sin is that it refuses to believe in Jesus and the Holy Spirit is the One that convicts the world of its sin.

**John 16:9–11 (ESV)** <sup>9</sup> concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; <sup>10</sup> concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer; <sup>11</sup> concerning judgment, because **the ruler of this world** is judged.

**Romans 10:13–15 (NLT)** <sup>13</sup> For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” <sup>14</sup> But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? <sup>15</sup> And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!”

**John 16:12–15 (NLT)** <sup>12</sup> There is so much more I want to tell you, but you can’t bear it now. <sup>13</sup> When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future. <sup>14</sup> He will bring me glory by telling you whatever he receives from me. <sup>15</sup> All that belongs to the Father is mine; this is why I said, ‘The Spirit will tell you whatever he receives from me.’
