The Priestly Blessing

²² And the Lord **spoke** to Moses, saying: ²³ "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This is the way you shall bless the children of Israel. Say to them: ²⁴ "The Lord bless you and keep you;
²⁵ The Lord make His face shine upon you,
And be gracious to you;
²⁶ The Lord lift up His countenance upon you,
And give you peace."
²⁷ "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and **I will bless them.**"

As the Levitical priesthood spoke this blessing over the people, it was a foreshadow of the Great High Priest . . . Jesus' blessing that He prays over us in the garden, found in John 17.

1 Peter 2:9 (NKJV) But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

Numbers 6:24 (NKJV) The Lord bless you and keep you

Numbers 6:25–26 (NKJV) ²⁵ The Lord make His **face** shine upon you, And be gracious to you; ²⁶ The Lord lift up His **countenance** upon you, And give you peace."

God promises this list: blessings, **keep**, grace, **favor** and mercy, **presence** and peace.

Numbers 6:27 (NKJV) "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and **I will** bless them."

Numbers 6:27 (NLT) Whenever Aaron and his sons bless the people of Israel in my name, I myself will bless them.
