I. Coming Rain v.54				
Translation — "And He turned also to the crowd and said, 'When you see a cloud arising in the west, immediately you will say, 'A rainstorm is coming.' And it will be so.'" v.54				
II. Blowing Wind v.55				
Translation — "And when (you see) a south wind blowing, you will say, 'It is going to get hot' and it will be so.' " v.55				
III. Interpreting the Times v.56				
Translation — "Hypocrites! You know how to interpret the appearance of the earth and the sky, but why do you not know how to interpret this present time?" v.56
