## Luke 14:1-14 Jesus Heals and Teaches I. Another Sabbath v. I

<b>Translation</b> — "And one sabbath day as He came into a house of one of the council of the Pharisees to eat a meal they were watching Him closely." v.l
II. Another Suffering Man vv.2-6  Translation — "And behold a certain man suffering from dropsy was there before Him." v.2
<b>Translation</b> — "Jesus asked the Pharisees and experts in religious law, 'Is it permitted in the law to heal people on the Sabbath day, or not?'" v.3
<b>Translation</b> — "But they declined to comment. And He took him, healed and dismissed him." v.4
<b>Translation</b> — "And He said to them, 'Which of you having a son or an ox fall into a pit will not immediately pull him out on a sabbath day?'" v.5

## Luke 14:1-14 Jesus Heals and Teaches

**Translation** — "But they were not able to refute these arguments." v.6

But Jesus was teaching that rules are secondary to the well-being of God's children.

## III. Another Sabbath Lesson v. I A Lesson to Guests and Host Translation — "And He began to propound a parable to the invited guests, when He noticed how they were choosing for themselves the best places, saying to them, ..." v.7

**Translation** — "Whenever you are invited by someone to a wedding feast, do not be seated in the best seat, lest a more prestigious person is present, having been invited by him." v.8

**Translation** — "And the one who invited you and him will come and say to you, 'Give this man your seat,' and then, overcome by embarrassment, you will proceed to step down to the last place." v.9

**Translation** — "Rather, when you have been invited, go and sit down in the last place, in order that when the one who invited you comes, he will say to you, 'Friend, move up higher.' Then you will be honored in the presence of all those dining with you." v.10

## Luke 14:1-14 Jesus Heals and Teaches

<b>Translation</b> — "Because everyone who exalts himself will be humiliated, but he who debases himself will be exalted." v.
<b>Translation</b> — "And He said also to the one who had invited Him, 'Whenever you give a dinner or a supper party, do not call your friends, nor your brothers, nor your relatives, nor your rich neighbors, lest they also invite you and you receive your reward." v.12
<b>Translation</b> — "Rather, whenever you give a reception, call poor, maimed, lame, blind people," v.13
<b>Translation</b> — "And you will be made happy, because they do not have the means to repay you. Therefore you will be rewarded at the resurrection of the just." v.14
