I. Kingdom Banquet vv.15-16

<b>Translation</b> — "And when one of those at the table with Him heard these things, he said to Him, 'Happy is the man who will eat bread in the kingdom of God.' " v.15
<b>Translation</b> — "And He said to him, 'A certain man planned to give a great supper, and he invited many." v.16
II. Guests Invited vv.17-20
<b>Translation</b> — "And he sent his servant at supper time to say to the guests, 'Come, because everything is now ready." v.17
<b>Translation</b> — "But all began at once to excuse themselves. The first said to him, 'I have bought a farm and I must go and inspect it. I beg you - consider me excused.'" v.18
<b>Translation</b> — "And another said, 'I have just bought five yoke of oxen and I am going to go to evaluate them. I beg you - consider me excused." v.19

<b>Translation</b> — "And another said, 'I have married a wife, and because of that, I am not able to come." v.20
III. Back to the Streets vv.21-24
<b>Translation</b> — "And the servant returned and told his master about it. Then because he was seized with rage the master of the house said to his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and alleys of the city and bring in here the poor and maimed and blind and lame.'" v.21
<b>Translation</b> — "And the servant said, 'Master, that which you ordered has been done; in fact there is yet room." v.22
Translation "A I.I. I. I.I. I.I. I.I.
<b>Translation</b> — "And the master said to the servant, 'Go out, into the highways and hedges and compel an entrance, in order that my house may be filled." v.23
<b>Translation</b> — "Because I am telling you that not one of those fellows who were invited are going to taste my supper." v.24
