I. Right Approach — Right Conclusion vv. I-2
Translation — "And all the publicans and sinners began to approach Him in order to hear Him." v.l
Translation — "Therefore both the Pharisees and the Scribes began to complain bitterly, saying, 'This fellow always welcomes sinners and eats with them.'" v.2
II. Lost Sheep vv.3-7 Translation — "So He began to portray to them this picture" v.3 Translation — "Which one of you men, if you had one hundred sheep but you lost one of them, would not leave the ninety nine in the wilderness and go after the one that was lost until he had found it" v.4
Translation — "And when he finds it, he places it upon his shoulders rejoicing" v.5

Luke 15:1-10 Lost and Found

Translation — "And when he comes into the house he calls together the friends and the neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, because I have found the sheep which has been lost." v.6
Translation — "I am telling you that in the same way there will be joy in heaven because of one repentant sinner rather than as a result of ninety-nine righteous people who have no need for repentance." v.7
III. Lost Coin vv.8-10 Translation — "Or what woman, if she has ten silver coins, and if she loses one, does not light a candle and sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it?" v.8
Translation — "And when she has found it she calls together the friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me, because I have found the silver coin which I lost." v.9
Translation — "So it is. I am telling you that there is joy among the angels of God as a result of one repentant sinner." v.10
