#### 1. REVIEW

- A. <u>James 1:2-4</u> (NASB) Consider it all <u>joy</u>, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, <u>knowing</u> that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And <u>let</u> endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.
- B. NOTE GOD DOES <u>NOT</u> <u>CAUSE</u> "<u>TRIALS</u>" BECAUSE HE IS A <u>GOOD</u> <u>FATHER</u>.
  - 1. LIKE A GOOD FATHER HE USES "TRIALS" TO MATURE US.
  - 2. GOD DOES <u>NOT ALLOW</u> "<u>TRIALS</u>" TO MAKE US <u>FALL</u>, THEY <u>ARE</u> MEANT TO MAKE US <u>SOAR</u>,
  - 3. GOD DOES NOT ALLOW "TRIALS" TO DEFEAT US, THEY ARE MEANT TO BE DEFEATED,
  - 4. GOD DOES NOT ALLOW "TRIALS" TO MAKE US WEAKER, THEY ARE MEANT TO MAKE US STRONGER,
  - 5. THEREFORE, JAMES SAYS... WE SHOULD NOT COMPLAIN ABOUT "TRIALS"... WE CAN HAVE AN ATTITUDE OF "JOY" AS WE GO THROUGH THEM..
- 2. THREE ESSENTIALS FOR VICTORY IN TRIALS:
  - A. THE FIRST ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR VICTORY IN TRIALS IS: A JOYFUL

    ATTITUDE ... "CONSIDER IT ALL JOY WHEN YOU ENCOUNTER VARIOUS TRIALS"...
  - B. THE SECOND ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR VICTORY IN TRIALS IS: AN UNDERSTANDING MIND... "KNOWING THAT THE TESTING OF YOUR FAITH PRODUCES INDURANCE.
  - C. THE THIRD ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR VICTORY IN TRIALS IS: A SURRENDERED WILL... "LET ENDURANCE HAVE ITS PERFECT RESULT SO THAT YOU MAY BE PERFECT AND COMPLETE LACKING IN NOTHING".
- 3. THE FIRST <u>ESSENTIAL</u> ELEMENT FOR <u>VICTORY</u> <u>IN</u> <u>TRIALS</u> IS: <u>A JOYFUL</u>

  <u>ATTITUDE</u> ... "<u>CONSIDER</u> IT ALL <u>JOY</u> WHEN YOU ENCOUNTER <u>VARIOUS</u>

  <u>TRIALS</u>"...
  - A. NOTE <u>OUTLOOK</u> <u>DETERMINES</u> <u>OUTCOME</u> AND <u>ATTITUDE</u> <u>DETERMINES</u> ACTION.
  - B. REMEMBER THAT WHEN WE <u>CHANGE</u> THE WAY WE <u>LOOK</u> AT <u>THINGS</u> ("TRIALS")... THE <u>THINGS</u> WE <u>LOOK</u> AT ("TRIALS") <u>CHANGE</u>!!

- C. JAMES TELLS US THT CHRISTIANS SHOULD EXPECT TRIALS.
  - 1. IT IS <u>NOT</u> A MATTER OF "<u>IF</u>" WE WILL "<u>ENCOUNTER</u> <u>VARIOUS</u> <u>TRIALS</u>", <u>BUT</u>... "<u>WHEN</u>" WE WILL "<u>ENCOUNTER</u> <u>VARIOUS</u> <u>TRIALS</u>".
    - a. THE <u>BELIEVER</u> WHO <u>EXPECTS</u> THEIR <u>CHRISTIAN LIFE</u> TO BE "<u>TRIAL</u>" <u>FREE</u> IS IN FOR A <u>SHOCK</u>.
    - b. IF CHRISTIANS LEARN TO ACCEPT THAT "TRIALS" ARE A PART OF LIFE AND THAT GOD WILL USE "TRIALS" TO MATURE US... WE WILL NOT BE SO SURPRIZED WHEN THEY COME... AND WE CAN RESPOND INSTEAD OF REACTING.
      - 1) **<u>RESPONDING</u>** INSTEAD OF <u>**REACTING</u>** IS 50% OF THE VICTORY!</u>
- D. A LOOK AT SOME REASONS WHY "TRIALS" COME IN CHRISTIANS LIVES:
  - 1. "TRIALS" COME BECAUSE OF THE "WORLD" WE LIIVE IN.
  - 2. "TRIALS" COME BECAUSE WE ARE HUMAN ("FLESH")
  - 3. "TRIALS" COME BECAUSE OF SATAN AND HIS DEMONS ("according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience.
  - 4. Ephesians 2:1-3 (NASB) And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world (WORLD), according to the prince of the power of the air (SATAN), of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh (FLESH), indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.
- 4. THE SECOND ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR VICTORY IN TRIALS IS:

  AN UNDERSTANDING MIND... "KNOWING THAT THE TESTING OF YOUR FAITH PRODUCES ENDURANCE.
  - A. WHAT SHOULD <u>CHRISTIANS</u> "KNOW" THAT MAKES IT <u>EASIER</u> TO <u>TURN</u> TRIALS INTO <u>TRIUMPHS</u>?...
    - 1. WE SHOULD "KNOW" THAT FAITH IS ALWAS TESTED.
    - 2. WE SHOULD "KNOW" THAT THE "TESTING OF OUR FAITH" ACTUALLY PROVES THAT WE ARE BORN AGAIN.
    - 3. WE SHOULD "KNOW" THAT "TRIALS" WORK FOR US, NOT AGAINST US
      BECAUSE SCRIPTURE SAYS THAT IS TRUE:

- a. Romans 8:28 (NASB) And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.
- b. 2 Corinthians 4:17-18 (NASB) For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.
  - 1) MOMENTARY... LIGHT AFFLICTION. VERSUS...
    - 1. ETERNAL... WEIGHT OF GLORY.
  - 2) THINGS <u>SEEN</u>... <u>TEMPORAL</u>. VERSUS...
    - i. THINGS <u>NOT SEEN</u>... <u>ETERNAL</u>.
- 4. CHRISTIANS SHOULD "KNOW" THAT "TRIALS" RIGHTLY USED HELP US TO MATURE.
  - a. Romans 5:3-5 (NASB) And not only this, but we also exult (= "JOY") in our tribulations ("TRIALS"), knowing that tribulation (TRIALS) brings about perseverance; and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope; and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
- B. THE "TESTING OF FAITH" HERE IS NOT INTENDED TO DETERMINE
  WHETHER A PERSON HAS "FAITH" OR NOT... IT IS INTENDED TO PURIFY
  AND STRENGTHEN THE "FAITH" THAT ALREADY EXISTS.
  - 1. ANOTHER WORD FOR "ENDURANCE" (NASB) IS "PATIENCE" (KJV, NKJV)
    - a. THE GREEK WORD FOR "ENDURANCE PATIENCE" PAINTS A WORD

      PICTURE OF THE QUALITY THAT IT TAKES FOR A RUNNER TO FINISH

      A MARATHON.

- 1) NOTE THE PURPOSE OF "TRIALS" IS NOT TO SNAP OUR FAITH MUSCLES... BUT, TO STRETCH AND STRENGTHEN OUR FAITH MUSCLES PRODUCING "ENDURANCE" TO FINISH THE RACE.
- a. IN THE <u>BIBLE</u> "<u>PATIENCE</u>/<u>ENDURANCE</u>" IS <u>NOT</u> A <u>PASSIVE</u>

  <u>ACCEPTANCE</u> OF <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>...
- b. IT IS <u>COURAGEOUS</u> <u>PERSEVERANCE</u> IN THE FACE OF <u>SUFFERING</u> AND <u>DIFFICULTY</u> ("<u>TRIALS</u>").
  - 1) NOTE GOD WANTS US TO BE "PATIENT" BECAUSE "PATIENCE" IS THE KEY TO EVERY OTHER BLESSING.
  - 2) WHEN BELIEVERS LEARN TO WAIT ON GOD'S TIMING ("PATIENCE") THEN "PATIENCE" CAN, AND WILL, DO GREAT THINGS FOR US.
- c. REMEMBER THE WAY GOD DEVELOPS "PATIENCE / ENDURANCE" IN OUR LIVES IS THROUGH "TRIALS".
- d. "<u>ENDURANCE</u>" CAN <u>NOT</u> BE <u>ATTAINED</u> BY <u>PRAYER</u> OR BY LISTENING TO A SERMON.
  - 1) "ENDURANCE/PATIENCE" COMES FROM GOING THROUGH THE DIFFICULTIES OF LIFE ("TRIALS") WHILE TRUSTING AND OBEYING GOD.
- 2. **SONG** "THROUGH IT ALL"
- 2. THE THIRD ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR VICTORY IN TRIALS IS: A SURRENDERED WILL... "LET (SURRENDER OUR WILL) ENDURANCE HAVE ITS PERFECT RESULT SO THAT YOU MAY BE PERFECT AND COMPLETE LACKING IN NOTHING".
  - A. NOTE GOD CAN NOT BRING US TO SPIRITUAL MATURITY IF WE RESIST GROWTH DURING "TRIALS".
    - 1. DISCUSS WAYS WE RESIST GROWTH DURING TRIALS.
    - 2. IF WE RESIST HIM HE ALLOWS MORE "TRIALS"... IF WE SUBMIT TO HIM DURING "TRIALS" HE WILL MATURE/GROW US SPIRITUALLY.

- B. REMEMBER GOD'S PRIMARY GOAL FOR OUR LIVES IS SPIRITUAL MATURITY.
- C. THREE **WORKS INVOLVED** IN OUR **SPIRITUAL MATURITY**:
  - 1. FIRST, THE <u>WORK GOD</u> DOES <u>FOR</u> US... <u>SALVATION</u>.
  - 2. SECOND, THE <u>WORK GOD</u> DOES <u>IN</u> US... <u>SANCTIFICATION</u>.
  - 3. THIRD, THE <u>WORK GOD</u> DOES <u>THROUGH</u> US... <u>SERVICE</u>.
    - a. NOTE GOD BUILDS CHARACTER (SPIRITUAL MATURITY) BEFORE HE CALLS US TO SERVICE.
    - b. AND HE BUILDS CHARACTER IN US THROUGH SALVATION AND SANCTIFICATION.
- D. HOWEVER GOD CAN NOT WORK FOR, IN, AND THROUGH US WITHOUT OUR CONSENT.
  - 1. THEREFORE WE MUST "SURRENDER OUR WILL" TO HIM BEFORE HE CAN WORK FOR, IN, AND THROUGH US.
  - 2. IF WE TRY TO GROW THROUGH "TRIALS" WITHOUT SURRENDERING OUR WILLS... WE WILL BECOME MORE LIKE IMMATURE CHILDREN THAN MATURE ADULTS.
- E. GOD CAN USE "TRIALS" TO WEAN US AWAY FROM CHILDISH PRIDE... BUT IF WE DO NOT SURRENDER OUR WILL TO HIM WE MAY BECOME MORE PRIDEFUL AND MORE IMMATURE!
- 3. CONCLUSION: JAMES SAYS THAT WHEN BELIEVERS RESPOND TO "TRIALS"
  WITH CONFIDENCE IN GOD AND A DETERMINATION TO ENDURE, WE WILL
  MATURE INTO A WHOLENESS OF GODLY CHARACTER.
  - A. IN SHORT... "TRIALS" CAN RESULT IN SPIRITUAL CHARACTER.
  - B. AND... REMEMBER THAT GOD'S PRIMARY GOAL FOR ALL CHRISTIANS IS SPIRITUAL MATURITY.
- 4. WISDOM

- A. <u>James 1:5</u> (NASB) But if any of you lacks <u>wisdom</u>, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.
- B. DISCUSS WHY DO YOU THINK JAMES DISCUSSES "WISDOM" IMEDIATELY AFTER 3 VERSES ABOUT "TRIALS"?
