- 1. OVERVIEW OF JAMES 1:2-12
 - A. JAMES **ANSWERS 3 QUESTIONS ABOUT "TRIALS"** IN JAMES 1:2-12.
 - 1. WHAT IS TRUE ABOUT "TRIALS"?
 - 2. **HOW** CAN WE **TRANSCEND**/**RISE ABOVE** "TRIALS"?
 - 3. WHEN WE HAVE HANDLED "TRIALS" PROPERLY, WHAT CAN WE EXPECT?
- 2. QUESSTION #1 WHAT IS TRUE ABOUT "TRIALS"?
 - A. FIRST, TRIALS ARE INEVITABLE!
 - 1. <u>James 1:2</u> (NASB) "Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials,..."
 - 2. NOTE "WHEN", NOT IF CHRISTIANS ENCOUNTER VARIOUS TRIALS!
 - a. BECAUSE WE ARE IN THE FAMILY OF GOD, TRIALS ARE INEVITABLE.

 THEY'RE INESCAPABLE. AND THEY'RE UNAVOIDABLE.
 - 1) <u>INTERESTINGLY</u>, ONE OF THE <u>CHARACTERISTICS</u> OF <u>HUMAN</u>

 <u>NATURE</u> IS WE <u>TRY</u> <u>TO AVOID</u> "TRIALS" BY:
 - i. **COMPLAINING** ABOUT THEM
 - ii. GOING AROUND THEM,
 - iii. OR BY TRYING TO GET AWAY FROM THEM.
 - 2) **BUT**... THE **TRUTH** IS THAT WE CAN **NOT AVOID THEM**.
 - B. **SECOND, TRIALS ARE "VARIOUS".**
 - 1. <u>James 1:2</u> (NASB) "Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter <u>various</u> trials,..."
 - 2. THE <u>GREEK</u> WORD FOR "<u>VARIOUS</u>" IS <u>poikilos</u>.
 - a. WE GET OUR WORD POLKA DOT FROM IT.

- 1) JUST AS THERE ARE <u>ALL KINDS OF DOTS</u>... THERE ARE <u>ALL KINDS</u> OF TRIALS.
- 3. SOME ARE <u>IRKSOME</u> AND <u>IRRITABLE</u> AND THEY SORT OF <u>COME</u> AND GO AND THEN MORE COME IN THEIR PLACE.
 - a. SOME ARE DEEP AND LIFE-THREATENING.
 - b. SOME ARE **OUTWARD** TRIALS THAT HAVE HAPPENED **TO** US.
 - c. AND SOME ARE **INWARD** THAT <u>HAPPENED</u> <u>WITHIN</u> <u>US</u>.

- 4. OUTWARD TRIALS... HARDSHIP, GRIEF, DISAPPOINTMENTS, FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES, LOSS OF JOB, FLAT TIRES, DEAD BATTERIES, BROKEN WRISTS AND HIPS AND ANKLES.
- 5. INWARD TRIALS... UNRESOLLVED CONFLICTS, FEELINGS OF REJECTION, BEING MISUNDERSTOOD, FEELING INSECURE, BATTLES OF THE FLESH (GREED, LUST, ANGER, PRIDE, JELOUSY, ARGUING, AND ENVY).
- C. THIRD, TRIALS COME WITH A PURPOSE.
 - 1. THEY CAN BE OPORTUNNITIES FOR US TO GROW SPIRITUALLY (SANCTIFICATION) IF WE HAVE POSITIVE ATTITUDE.
 - 2. WE WILL NOT MATURE (GROW SPIRITUALLY) IF WE LOOK FOR AN ESCAPE HATCH BY...
 - a. **COMPLAINING**
 - b. BLAMING/JUDGING OTHERS
 - c. LIVE IN DENIAL
 - d. BECOME ANGRY
 - e. LIVING IN FEAR

- 3. <u>James 1:2-4</u> NLB When all kinds of **trials** and temptations crowd into your life, my brothers and sisters, don't **resent** them as intruders, but welcome them as friends. Realize that they come to test your faith and to produce in you the quality of **endurance**. Let the process go on until that endurance is **fully developed**. And you will find that you have become men and women of mature <u>character</u>.
- 4. IT IS MUCH BETTER TO ASK GOD WHAT IS IN THIS TRIAL THAT I NEED

 TO LEARN... THAN ASKING WHY HAS THIS HAPPENED, AND WHY DID IT

 HAPPEN TO ME?
- 3. QUESTION #2 HOW CAN WE TRANSCEND/RISE ABOVE "TRIALS"?
 - A. <u>NOW</u> THAT WE <u>UNDERSTAND</u> THAT <u>TRIALS</u> ARE <u>INEVITABLE</u> AND THAT THEY CAN BE <u>PURPOSEFUL</u>...
 - 1. ...<mark>HOW</mark> CAN WE TRANSCEND/RISE ABOVE THEM AND STAY ON TOP OF THEM...
 - a. SO THAT WE ARE ABLE TO GO THROUGH THEM WITHOUT THEM DRAGGING US DOWN?
 - B. <u>FOUR WORDS</u> JAMES USES TO HELP US <u>UNDERSTAND</u> <u>HOW</u> WE CAN <u>MATURE</u> <u>THROUGH</u> <u>TRIALS</u>.
 - 1. "CONSIDER"

<u>James 1:2</u> (NASB) <u>Consider</u> it all <u>joy</u>, my brethren, when you encounter various trials,

- a. THAT DOES NOT MEAN A LAUGHING "JOY" ... THAT WOULD BE SILLY AND INAPPROPRIATE.
- b. "JOY" IS USED HERE TO MEAN A STEADFAST POSITIVE SPIRIT.
 - 1) IT MEANS A DEPTH OF UNDERSTANDING THAT SAYS, THERE
 IS A REASON FOR THIS.

2) ... AND IF I CAN KNOW MY GOD BETTER, I WILL UNDERSTAND
BETTER WHAT HIS PURPOSE IS IN ALLOWING (NOT CAUSING)
THIS TO HAPPEN!

2. "KNOW"

- a. <u>James 1:3</u> (NASB) <u>knowing</u> that the testing of your faith produces endurance.
- b. "KNOWING" THAT THIS TRIAL IS <u>DEEPENING</u> YOUR FAITH, AND THAT IT IS <u>INCREASING</u> YOUR <u>ENDURANCE</u>, AND IT IS <u>ENHANCING</u> YOUR <u>CHARACTER</u>, AND THAT IT IS <u>BUILDING</u> YOUR <u>MATURITY</u>.
 - 1) "KNOWING" THAT THE "TRIAL" CAN BE FOR MY GROWTH IF I APPROACH IT WITH A POSITIVE ATTITUDE.
 - 2) NOTE ALL OF THOSE VIRTUES COME ON THE PLATFORM OF A "TRIAL".
- C. "I LOOK BACK ON EXPERIENCES THAT AT THE TIME SEEMED ESPECIALLY DESOLATING AND PAINFUL WITH PARTICULAR SATISFACTION. INDEED, I CAN SAY WITH COMPLETE TRUTHFULNESS THAT EVERYTHING I HAVE LEARNED IN MY 75 YEARS, EVERYTHING THAT HAS TRULY ENHANCED AND ENLIGHTENED MY EXISTENCE HAS BEEN THROUGH AFFLICTION AND NOT THROUGH HAPPINESS."

 MALCOM MUGGERIDGE
- d. "DON'T BE DEFINED BY WHAT LIFE THROWS AT YOU AND YOU CANNOT CONTROL. ACCEPT THE HAND YOU ARE DEALT WITH GRACE. AND THEN GO ON TO PLAY THAT HAND AS JOYOUSLY AND

INDUSTRIOUSLY AND VIGOROUSLY AS YOU CAN."
DANIEL KRAUTHAMMER

1. "<mark>ASK</mark>"

- **a.** <u>James 1:5</u> (NASB) But if any of you lacks <u>wisdom</u>, let him <u>ask</u> of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.
- b. NOTE "ASK" IS PRECEDED BY THE REASON YOU ARE "ASKING"...
 - 1) = "WISDOM" JAMES DEFINES "WISDOM" AS LOOKING AT OUR LIFE FROM GOD'S POINT OF VIEW.
 - 2) **WISDOM** IS SOMETHING YOU AND I WERE NOT BORN WITH.
 - 3) WE <u>CANNOT</u> <u>INHERIT</u> <u>IT</u>.
 - 4) WE <u>CANNOT</u> TAKE A <u>COURSE AT SCHOOL</u>, <u>NOT EVEN A</u>

 <u>GRADUATE SCHOOL</u> THAT <u>TEACHES</u> <u>US WISDOM</u>.
- c. THE <u>WISDOM</u> JAMES IS WRITING ABOUT <u>ONLY</u> <u>COMES</u> FROM THE <u>MIND</u> <u>OF OUR</u> <u>GOD</u>, AND HE IS <u>WILLING TO SHARE</u> <u>IT</u> WITH US AT THOSE TIMES <u>WHEN</u> <u>WE NEED IT THE MOST</u>... DURING TIMES OF "<u>TRIALS</u>".
- d. PRAYER (= "ASK") "LORD, I'M IN THE MIDST OF A MESS. IT'S A SITUATION PART OF WHICH I CAUSED AND PART OF WHICH I DIDN'T, BUT I'M HERE. AND IT HAS BROUGHT MAYBE LOSS OR HEARTACHE OR A FEELING OF FAILURE, DISAPPOINTMENT TO MYSELF AND TO OTHERS. SO I NEED YOU TO ENABLE ME TO SEE THROUGH YOUR PERSPECTIVE WHAT I CAN LEARN THROUGH THIS. HELP ME LORD TO LEARN FROM THIS EXPERIENCE YOUR PERSPECTIVE ON THE SITUATION. HELP ME TO SEE WHAT'S OCCURRED AND PERHAPS BY YOUR GRACE WHY IT'S HAPPENED SO THAT I CAN GROW IN AN UNDERSTANDING OF IT. I NEED YOUR WISDOM BECAUSE I DON'T HAVE IT IN MYSELF."
- e. <u>CHRISTIANS</u> SHOULD <u>NEVER ALLOW</u> THE <u>OPPORTUNNITY</u> OF A <u>TRIAL</u> TO BE <u>WASTED</u>.
 - 1) THE SECRET TO ENDURING IS IN "ASKING" FOR THE WISDOM WE NEED TO GET US THROUGH THE EVENTS OF THE TRIAL.
- 2. "ENDURE"

- a. <u>James 1:3-4</u> (NASB) knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.
- b. "ENDURE" IS FROM THE GREEK TERM "HUPOMENO".
 - 1) HUPO MEANS UNDER AND MENO MEANS TO ABIDE OR TO REMAIN.
 - 2) THE WORDS <u>TOGETHER</u> MEAN <u>TO REMAIN UNDER</u>.
- c. IT WAS USED TO <u>DESCRIBE</u> A <u>BEAST</u> <u>OF</u> <u>BURDEN</u> <u>LOADED DOWN</u> FOR A <u>TRIP</u> AND THE ANIMAL WOULD "<u>HUPOMENO</u>"... <u>ABIDE</u> <u>UNDER THE LOAD</u>.
- d. THAT ("HUPOMENO") IS WHAT WE ARE CALLED TO DO IN TRIALS.
- e. GOD <u>WANTS</u> TO <u>CULTIVATE</u> <u>CHARACTER</u> AND <u>MATURITY</u> IN US

 <u>WHEN</u> WE <u>ENDURE</u> THE <u>TRIALS</u> AS THEY COME AND <u>RATHER THAN</u>

 <u>COMPLAIN</u> ABOUT THEM.
 - 1) COMPLAINING MAKES US AND OTHER PEOPLE MISERABLE BECAUSE OF OUR TRIAL.
- B. <u>James 1:9-11</u> (NASB) But the brother of humble circumstances is to glory in his high position; and the rich man is to glory in his humiliation, because like flowering grass he will pass away. For the sun rises with a scorching wind and withers the grass; and its flower falls off and the beauty of its appearance is destroyed; so too the rich man in the midst of his pursuits will fade away.
 - 1. <u>NEXT</u> JAMES SAYS A WORD TO THE <u>POOR</u>, <u>AND</u> A WORD TO THE <u>RICH</u> REGARDING "TRIALS".
 - a. HIS POINT IS THAT REGARDLESS OF OUR FINANCIAL STATUS ALL CHRISTIANS WILL FACE "TRIALS".

- b. ... AND WHEN WE ENDURE "TRIALS", WHETHER WE ARE POOR OR RICH OR IN BETWEEN, THERE WILL BE OPPORTUNITIES FOR SPIRITUAL GROWTH.
- 2. CHRISTIANITY GIVES THE POOR A NEW SENSE OF THEIR OWN VALUE.
 - a. IN THE <u>EARLY CHURCH</u>, THERE WERE <u>NO CLASS</u> <u>DISTINCTIONS</u>.

- b. IN THE <u>CHURCH TODAY</u>, THE SOCIAL DISTINCTIONS OF THE WORLD <u>SHOULD BE OBLITERATED</u> SO THAT <u>NO INDIVIDUAL MATTERS MORE</u> <u>THAN ANY OTHER</u>.
- 3. **CHRISTIANITY** GIVES THE **RICH** A **NEW SENSE** OF **SELF**.
 - a. THE GREAT PERIL OF RICHES IS THAT THEY TEND TO GIVE PEOPLE A FALSE SENSE OF SECURITY.
- 4. ONE OF THE <u>MOST</u> <u>DISAPPOINTING</u> THINGS ABOUT CHURCHS THAT ARE MORE <u>SOCIAL</u> THAN <u>SPIRITUAL</u> IS THAT THEY PLACE <u>LITTLE</u> <u>VALUE</u> ON <u>PEOPLE</u> WHO ARE <u>FINANCIALLY</u> "<u>POOR</u>"!
- 2. QUESTION #3 WHEN WE HAVE HANDLED "TRIALS" PROPERLY, WHAT CAN WE EXPECT?
 - A. THE **SECRET** IS IN **UNDERSTANDING JAMES 1:12**
 - B. <u>James 1:12 (NLT2) God blesses</u> those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.
 - C. <u>James 1:12</u> (NASB) <u>Blessed</u> is a man who <u>perseveres</u> under <u>trial</u>; for once he has been approved, he will receive the <u>crown of life</u> which *the Lord* has promised to those who <u>love Him</u>.

- D. THE <u>ANSWER</u> TO THE <u>FOURTH</u> <u>QUESTION</u>... (<u>WHEN</u> WE HAVE HANDLED "TRIALS" PROPERLY, <u>WHAT CAN WE EXPECT?</u>)... IS THAT <u>GOD</u> <u>BLESSES</u> THOSE WHO <u>PATIENTLY</u> <u>ENDURE</u> "<u>TRIALS</u>".
 - 1. IF WE HANDLE "TRIALS" GOD'S WAY RATHER THAN IN THE FLESH,
 THERE IS A SENSE OF SATISFACTION WHICH JAMES CALLS BLESSINGS
 FROM GOD.
 - 2. NOTE THE BENEFITS/BLESSINGS WILL BE OURS IN THE PRESENT AS WELL AS IN ETERNITY, ALTHOUGH WE WILL STILL FACE TRIALS WHILE ON EARTH.
 - 3. ARE YOU <u>AWARE</u> THAT WHEN WE <u>DIE</u> AND WE STAND BEFORE OUR LORD FOR THE TIME OF <u>REWARDS</u> BY HIS <u>GRACE</u>, THAT THERE ARE LITERAL "<u>CROWNS</u>" THAT HE HAS SET ASIDE FOR US?
 - a. THE "CROWN" IS THE EMBLEM OF SPIRITUAL SUCCESS, GIVEN BY

 GOD TO THOSE WHO KEEP THEIR FAITH IN THE MIDST OF "TRIALS".
 - 1) "LIFE" SHOULD BE TAKEN AS IDENTIFYING THE REWARD.
 - 2) THIS "LIFE" IS NOT PHYSICAL LIFE... BUT ETERNAL LIFE.
 - i. THE ENJOYMENT OF GOD'S PRESENCE ON INTO ETERNITY.
 - b. <u>FIVE CROWNS</u> ARE NAMED IN THE <u>NEW TESTAMENT</u>.
 - 1) THE IMPERRISHABLE CROWN. (1 Corinthians 9:25)
 - 2) THE CROWN OF EXAULTATION. (1 Thessalonians 2:19)
 - 3) THE <u>CROWN</u> OF <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>. (2 Timothy 4:8)
 - 4) THE <u>CROWN</u> OF <u>GLORY</u>. (<u>1 Peter 5:4</u>)
 - 5) THE <u>CROWN</u> OF <u>LIFE</u>. (James 1:12)

3. **CONCLUSION**

A. TWO WAYS THAT WE SHOULD HANDLE ADVERSITY/TRIALS:

- JAMES PRACTICAL LESSONS IN SPIRITUAL MATURITY
 JAMES 1:2-12 ANSWERS 3 QUESTIONS ABOUT TRIALS
- 1. WHEN TROUBLES COME, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT WE RESPOND WITH WISDOM.
 - a. REMEMBER THIS INSIGHT INTO TRIALS DOES NOT COME

 NATURALLY... WISDOM FOR HANDLING TRIALS CAN COME ONLY
 FROM GOD,
 - 1) AND THE PRIMARY MEANS HE USES TO GIVE US WISDOM IS HIS WORD.
- 2. WHEN TROUBLES COME, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT WE RESPOND IN FAITH.
 - a. IN THE <u>CONTEXT</u> OF <u>TRIALS</u>, <u>FAITH</u> MEANS HAVING <u>ABSOLUTE</u>

 <u>CONFIDENCE</u> IN <u>GOD'S PROMISES</u> <u>DESPITE</u> <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u> THAT <u>APPEAR</u> TO <u>CONTRADICT</u> THOSE <u>PROMISES</u>.
 - 1) TO THOSE WHO LACK THE WISDOM AND FAITH TO SEE BEYOND THEIR CIRCUMSTANCES, IT MAY APPEAR THAT OUR LIVES ARE IN A TAILSPIN, HEADING FOR CATASTROPHE.
 - 2) BUT SINGLE-MINDED, FOCUSED FAITH MEANS MAKING A CONSCIOUS DECISION, WITH GOD'S HELP, TO CHOOSE OUR ATTITUDE.
 - i. IT MEANS <u>SURRENDERING</u> <u>FULLY</u> <u>TO</u> <u>GOD</u> BECAUSE WE <u>TRUST</u> HIM, AND <u>RESIST</u> OUR <u>NATURAL</u> <u>TENDENCY</u> TO <u>ABANDON</u> <u>HOPE</u>.
