- 1. THE PROBLEM: TWO VIEWS OF "JUSTIFICATION".
 - A. PAUL WROTE... Ephesians 2:8-9 (NASB) For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.
 - 1. Romans 3:28 (NASB) For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law.
 - B. JAMES WROTE... James 2:21,24 (NASB) Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up Isaac his son on the altar?... You see that a man is justified by works and not by faith alone.
 - C. THOSE <u>VIEW POINTS</u> SEEM TO BE <u>DIAMETRICALLY</u> <u>OPPOSED</u> TO EACH OTHER.

2. THE SOLUTION

- A. PAUL AND JAMES USE THE SAME WORD FOR "JUSTIFY", BUT WITH TWO DIFFERENT MEANINGS... THESE TWO MEANINGS ARE ACTUALLY TWO SIDES OF THE SAME COIN. (SEE THE CHART ON PAGE 8)
- B. THE SOLUTION INVOLVES TWO DIFFERENT NUANCES OF THE WORD "TO JUSTIFY."
 - 1. THE <u>GREEK VERB FOR "JUSTIFY</u>" IS <u>DIKAIOŌ</u>... AND <u>DEPENDING</u> ON THE <u>CONTEXT</u>, THE WORD CAN <u>MEAN</u> <u>EITHER</u>:
 - a. "TO <u>DECLARE</u> <u>RIGHTEOUS</u>," AS IN A <u>LEGAL</u> <u>PROCEEDING</u>, = A <u>JUDGMENT</u>.
 - b. OR, "TO <u>DEMONSTRATE</u> <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>" = <u>ACTION</u> = <u>GOOD</u> <u>WORKS</u>.
 - 2. PAUL: "TO DECLARE RIGHTEOUS", WHICH IS THE LEGAL DEFINITION, IS TO DECLARE A VERDICT OF "GUILTY" OR "NOT GUILTY" PRONOUNCED BY A JUDGE (GOD THE FINAL JUDGE).
 - 3. JAMES, "TO DEMONSTRATE RIGHTEOUSNESS", A PERSON
 DEMONSTRATES THEIR RIGHTNESS BY ACTIONS THAT ARE OBSERVED
 BY OTHERS.
- C. SO... PAUL AND JAMES USE "JUSTIFY" IN TWO DIFFERENT WAYS, <u>BUT</u>
 THESE TWO USES ARE <u>ACTUALLY TWO SIDES</u> OF THE SAME COIN.
- D. <u>ADDITIONAL CLARIFICATION</u> OF THE <u>APPARENT</u> <u>CONFLICT</u> OF HOW <u>PAUL</u> AND <u>JAMES</u> USE THE WORD "<u>JUSTIFICATION</u>":
 - 1. PAUL IS LOOKING AT THE ROOT OF SALVATION.

- a. <u>AT</u> THE <u>MOMENT</u> OF <u>SALVATION</u> (<u>PRESENT</u> <u>TENSE</u>), A PERSON IS SAVED <u>THROUGH</u> <u>FAITH</u> <u>PLUS</u> <u>NOTHING</u>.
- 2. JAMES IS LOOKING AT THE FRUIT OF SALVATION.
 - a. AFTER SALVATION (PAST TENSE) AFTER THE ROOT OF FAITH HAS BEEN PLANTED, OUR LIVES WILL BEAR THE FRUIT OF GOOD WORKS.
- 3. ANOTHER **CONTRAST** INVOLVES **TWO DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES**:
 - a. PAUL LOOKS AT LIFE FROM GOD'S PERSPECTIVE
 - 1) PAUL USES THE WORD "JUSTIFIED" TO MEAN "DECLARED RIGHTEOUS IN THE SIGHT OF GOD IN THE PRESENT TENSE.
 - b. **JAMES** LOOKS AT <u>LIFE</u> FROM THE <u>HUMAN</u> <u>PERSPECTIVE</u>...
 - 1) HE IS ADDRESSING <u>BELIEVERS</u> WHO HAVE <u>ALREADY</u> <u>EXPERIENCED</u> THIS <u>GIFT</u> OF <u>SALVATION</u>...
 - i. SO JAMES USES THE WORD "JUSTIFIED" TO MEAN

 "DEMONSTRATE MYSELF TO BE RIGHTEOUSNESS IN THE

 SIGHT OF PEOPLE TO SHOW THAT I HAVE RECEIVED (PAST TENSE) GOD'S GIFT OF ETERNAL LIFE."
- 3. REVIEW: DEAD FAITH
 - A. ANY DECLARATION OF FAITH THAT DOES NOT RESULT IN A CHANGED LIFE AND GOOD WORKS IS A FALSE DECLARATION.
 - 1. <u>DEAD FAITH IS OUTWARDLY INOPERATIVE</u> AND <u>INWARDLY DEAD</u>... IT IS <u>INACTIVE</u>, <u>INERT</u>... WHICH JAMES SAYS IS <u>DEAD FAITH</u>.
 - B. THE PERSON WITH **DEAD FAITH** HAS **ONLY** AN **INTELLECTUAL EXPERIENCE.**
 - 1. THEY KNOW ABOUT THE DOCTRINE OF SALVATION IN THEIR MINDS,

 BUT THEY HAVE NEVER SUBMITTED THEIR WILL TO GOD AND TRUSTED CHRIST FOR SALVATION.
 - 2. THEY KNOW THE RIGHT WORDS, BUT THEY DO NOT BACK UP THEIR WORDS WITH THEIR WORKS.
 - a. PEOPLE WITH <u>DEAD FAITH SUBSTITUTE WORDS FOR DEEDS</u>.
 - 3. THEY KNOW THE CORRECT VOCABULARY FOR PRAYER AND TESTIMONY, AND CAN EVEN QUOTE THE RIGHT VERSES FROM THE BIBLE... BUT THEIR WALK DOES NOT MEASURE UP TO THEIR TALK.
 - a. THEY <u>THINK</u> THAT THEIR <u>WORDS</u> ARE <u>AS GOOD AS</u> <u>WORKS</u>, AND <u>THEY ARE <u>WRONG</u>!</u>

- C. FAITH IN CHRIST BRINGS LIFE (JOHN 3:16), AND WHERE THERE IS LIFE THERE WILL BE GROWTH AND FRUIT.
 - 1. <u>1 Timothy 6:18-19</u> (NLT2) Tell them to use their money to do good. They should be rich in good works and generous to those in need, always being ready to share with others. By doing this they will be storing up their treasure as a good foundation for the future so that they may experience true life.
 - 2. <u>Galatians 2:20</u> (NLT2) My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who <u>live</u>, but Christ <u>lives</u> in me. So I <u>live</u> in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
 - 3. **DISCUSS**... **GROWTH** AND **FRUIT**.
- D. CONCLUSION DEAD FAITH IS NOT SAVING FAITH.
 - 1. DEAD FAITH IS COUNTERFEIT FAITH AND LULLS A PERSON INTO A SENSE OF FALSE (AND OFTEN HYPOCRITICAL) CONFIDENCE.

4. **DEMONIC FAITH**

- A. <u>James 2:18-19</u> (NLT2) Now someone may argue, "Some people have faith; others have good deeds." But I say, "How can you show me your faith if you don't have good deeds? I will show you my faith by my good deeds." You say you have faith, for you <u>believe</u> that there is <u>one God</u>. Good for you!

 <u>Even the demons believe</u> this, and they <u>tremble</u> in terror.
- B. <u>JAMES</u> WANTED TO <u>SHOCK</u> HIS <u>COMPLACENT</u> <u>READERS</u>, SO HE <u>USED</u> <u>DEMONS</u> AS HIS <u>NEXT ILLUSTRATION</u>.
- C. IT COMES AS A SHOCK TO MOST PEOPLE TOFAY TO FIND OUT THAT DEMONS HAVE FAITH... WHAT DO THEY BELIEVE?
 - 1. **DEMONS** "BELIEVE" IN THE EXISTENCE OF GOD;
 - a. "you <u>believe</u> that there is <u>one God</u>. Good for you! <u>Even the <mark>demons</mark> <u>believe</u> <u>this</u>..."</u>
 - 2. <u>DEMONS</u> ALSO "<u>BELIEVE</u>" IN THE <u>DEITY</u> <u>OF</u> <u>CHRIST</u>.
 - a. WHEN DEMONS MET CHRIST WHEN HE WAS ON EARTH, THEY BORE WITNESS TO HIS SONSHIP.
 - 1) Mark 3:11 (NLT2) And whenever those possessed by evil spirits caught sight of him, the spirits would throw them to the ground in front of him shrieking, "You are the Son of God!"
 - 3. <u>DEMONS</u> "<u>BELIEVE</u>" IN THE <u>EXISTENCE</u> OF A <u>PLACE</u> <u>OF</u> <u>PUNISHMENT</u>,
 - a. <u>Luke 8:31</u> (NLT2) The demons kept begging Jesus not to send them into the **bottomless pit**.

- 4. <u>DEMONS</u> <u>BELIEVE</u> IN <u>JESUS CHRIST</u> AS THE <u>JUDGE</u> AND THEY <u>SUBMIT</u> TO THE <u>POWER</u> OF HIS <u>WORD</u>... HIS <u>SPOKEN</u> <u>WORD</u>.
 - a. THERE IS GREAT POWER IN THE SPIRITUAL WORLD IN SPEAKING GOD'S WORD.
 - 1) ... "SPEAKING GOD'S WORD INTO THE FABRIC OF LIFE".
 - b. MARK 5:10-13 (NLT2) Then the evil spirits begged him again and again not to send them to some distant place. There happened to be a large herd of pigs feeding on the hillside nearby. "Send us into those pigs," the spirits begged. "Let us enter them." So Jesus gave them permission. The evil spirits came out of the man and entered the pigs, and the entire herd of 2,000 pigs plunged down the steep hillside into the lake and drowned in the water. (= THE FIRST "SWINE DIVE"!!)
- D. <u>PEOPLE</u> WITH <u>DEAD</u> <u>FAITH</u> HAVE BEEN ALTERED <u>ONLY</u> IN THEIR <u>INTELLECT</u> <u>AND</u> THEIR <u>BUT</u> THE <u>DEMONS</u> ARE <u>INFLUENCED</u> IN THEIR <u>INTELLECT</u> <u>AND</u> THEIR <u>EMOTIONS</u>... THEY "<u>BELIEVE</u>" (<u>INTELLECT</u>) AND "<u>TREMBLE</u>" (<u>EMOTIONS</u>).
 - 1. <u>BUT</u> THEIR <u>BELIEF</u> IS <u>NOT</u> A <u>SAVING</u> <u>EXPERIENCE</u>.
 - a. A PERSON CAN BE <mark>ENLIGHTENED</mark> IN THEIR MIND AND EVEN STIRRED IN THEIR HEART AND STILL BE LOST FOREVER.
 - b. TRUE SAVING FAITH INVOLVES SOMETHING MORE... SOMETHING
 THAT CAN BE SEEN AND RECOGNIZED: A CHANGED LIFE REFLECTED
 IN GOOD WORKS.
 - c. James 2:18 (NLT2) Now someone may argue, "Some people have faith; others have good deeds." But I say, "How can you show me your faith if you don't have good deeds? I will show you my faith by my good deeds."
- E. JAMES ASKS, "How can <u>you show</u> me your <u>faith</u> <u>if</u> you <u>don't</u> <u>have good</u> deeds?
 - 1. <u>CAN</u> A <u>DEAD</u> <u>SINNER</u> PERFORM <u>GOOD</u> <u>WORKS</u>?... <u>NO</u>, THAT'S IMPOSSIBLE!

- 2. WHEN WE <u>RECEIVED</u> <u>CHRIST</u>, WE WERE THEN "... created in Christ Jesus for (NOT "BY") good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10 (NASB)
- 3. BEING A BELIEVER INVOLVES TRUSTING CHRIST AND LIVING FOR CHRIST; FIRST WE RECEIVE THE LIFE, THEN WE REVEAL THE LIFE.
- F. JAMES HAS INTRODUCED TWO KINDS OF FAITH THAT CAN NEVER SAVE A SINNER:
 - 1. DEAD FAITH (THE INTELLECT ALONE), AND
 - 2. <u>DEMONIC FAITH</u> (<u>INTELLECT</u> <u>AND</u> <u>EMOTIONS</u>).
 - 3. JAMES CLOSES THIS SECTION BY DESCRIBING THE ONLY KIND OF FAITH

 THAT CAN SAVE A SINNER... DYNAMIC FAITH.

5. **DYNAMIC FAITH**

- A. <u>James 2:20-26</u> (NLT2) How foolish! Can't you see that faith without good deeds is useless? Don't you remember that our ancestor Abraham was shown to be right with God by his actions when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? You see, his faith and his actions worked together. His actions made his faith complete. And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." He was even called the friend of God. So you see, we are shown to be right with God by what we do, not by faith alone. Rahab the prostitute is another example. She was shown to be right with God by her actions when she hid those messengers and sent them safely away by a different road. Just as the body is dead without breath, so also faith is dead without good works.
- B. JAMES CONTINUES WITH HIS FAMILIAR PATTERN OF WRITING:
 - 1. <u>FIRST</u> HE <u>STATES</u> THE <u>PPRINCIPLE</u>:
 - a. <u>James 2:20-26</u> (NLT2) How foolish! Can't you see that faith without good deeds is useless?
 - 2. THEN HE GIVES AN EXAMPLE:
 - a. ABRAHAM AND RAHAB
 - 3. AND HE <u>ENDS</u> WITH A <u>CALL</u> <u>TO</u> <u>ACTION</u> BASED ON THE <u>PRINCIPLE</u>:
 - a. "... Just as the body is dead without breath, so also faith is dead without good works."
- C. **DYNAMIC FAITH** IS:
 - 1. FAITH THAT IS REAL,

- 2. FAITH THAT HAS POWER,
- 3. FAITH THAT RESULTS IN A CHANGED LIFE.
 - a. AND... THAT <u>CHANGED</u> <u>LIFE</u> <u>PRODUCES</u> <u>GOOD</u> <u>WORKS</u>.
- D. FAITH IS ONLY AS GOOD AS ITS OBJECT.
 - 1. NO MATTER HOW MUCH FAITH A PERSON MAY GENERATE, IF IT IS NOT DIRECTED AT THE RIGHT OBJECT, IT WILL ACCOMPLISH NOTHING.
 - 2. "I BELIEVE" MAY BE THE TESTIMONY OF MANY SINCERE PEOPLE, BUT THE BIG QUESTION IS, "IN WHOM OR WHAT DO YOU BELIEVE?
- E. <u>EASY</u> <u>BELIEVISM</u> IS A <u>TERM</u> THAT <u>DESCRIBES</u> WHAT JAMES IS <u>TALKING</u> <u>ABOUT</u> WHEN HE WRITES ABOUT <u>FAITH</u> <u>WITHOUT</u> <u>WORKS</u>.
 - 1. "EASY BELIEVISM" IS A <u>TERM</u> THAT COMES FROM WHAT MANY PEOPLE UNDERSTAND THE WORD "BELIEVE" TO MEAN.
 - a. **JOHN 3:16 (NLT2)** "For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who **believes** in him will not perish but have eternal life".
 - 2. THE <u>DEFINITION</u> OF "<u>BELIEVE</u>" IN <u>AMERICA</u> TODAY IS TO "<u>BELIEVE</u>" THAT <u>SOMETHING EXISTS</u> OR <u>EXISTED</u>.
 - a. MANY PEOPLE WILL SAY "<u>OH YES</u>... <u>I</u> '<u>BELIEVE</u>' <u>IN JESUS</u>, SO <u>LEAVE</u> <u>ME ALONE</u>."
 - 1) WHAT THEY **MEAN** IS THAT THEY **BELIEVE** THAT **JESUS EXISTED**.
 - 2) <u>ALL</u> THEY ARE DOING IS TO <u>NOD THEIR HEAD</u> THAT THEY <u>BELIEVE</u>
 IN <u>JESUS</u> WHICH IS <u>INTELLECTUAL</u> <u>AGREEMENT</u>... AND JAMES
 SAYS THAT <u>INTELLECTUAL</u> <u>AGREEMENT</u> <u>ALONE</u> IS <u>DEAD</u> <u>FAITH</u>.
 - 3) JAMES SAID THAT EVEN THE <u>DEMONS</u> HAVE <u>INTELLECTUAL</u>
 FAITH.
 - 3. <u>BUT</u>... <u>DYNAMIC</u> <u>FAITH</u> GOES <u>FAR</u> <u>BEYOND</u> <u>INTELLECTUAL</u> <u>AGREEMENT</u> THAT <u>SOMETHING</u> OR <u>SOMEONE</u> <u>EXISTS</u> OR <u>EXISTED</u>!
 - a. DYNAMIC FAITH IS FAITH THAT RESULTS IN ACTION... A CHANGED LIFE...
 - 1) AND THAT <u>CHANGED</u> <u>LIFE</u> IS <u>PROVEN</u> BY <u>GOOD</u> <u>WORKS</u>!
 - 2) <u>BELIEVERS</u> DO <u>NOT</u> "<u>DO</u>" <u>GOOD WORKS</u> <u>IN ORDER</u> <u>TO BE SAVED</u>... <u>BELIEVERS</u> "<u>DO</u>" <u>GOOD WORKS</u> <u>BECAUSE</u> <u>THEY ARE SAVED</u>! THEREFORE, OUR <u>FAITH</u> IS <u>PROVEN</u> <u>BY</u> OUR <u>GOOD WORKS</u>!
 - 4. A <u>BETTER</u> <u>TERM</u> FOR "<u>BELIEVE</u>" IS "<u>RECEIVE</u>".
 - a. DO WE **RECEIVE** JESUS CHRIST?

- b. DO WE "RECEIVE" JESUS CHRIST AS <u>OUR</u> <u>SAVIOR</u>... AS OPPOSED TO, DO WE "<u>BELIEVE</u>" THAT <u>JESUS</u> <u>EXISTED</u>?
- F. **DEAD FAITH TOUCHES ONLY OUR INTELLECT**;
 - 1. <u>DEMONIC FAITH INVOLVES BOTH OUR MIND AND OUR EMOTIONS</u>;
 - 2. BUT... DYNAMIC FAITH INVOLVES OUR INTELLECT, OUR EMOTIONS, AND OUR WILL.
 - 3. THE <u>WHOLE PERSON</u> PLAYS A PART IN <u>TRUE SAVING DYNAMIC FAITH</u>.
 - a. OUR MIND UNDERSTANDS THE TRUTH;
 - b. OUR **EMOTIONS**/**HEART DESIRE** THE **TRUTH**;
 - c. AND OUR WILL ACTS ON THE TRUTH.
 - d. <u>DYNAMIC TRUTH LEADS</u> TO <u>ACTION</u> BY <u>DOING GOOD WORKS</u>.
- G. THE **EXAMPLE** OF **ABRAHAM**:
 - 1. <u>James 2:21-24</u> (NLT2) Don't you remember that our ancestor <u>Abraham</u> was shown to be right with God <u>by his actions</u> when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? You see, <u>his faith</u> and his <u>actions</u> worked together. His <u>actions</u> made his <u>faith</u> complete. And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." He was even called the friend of God. So you see, we are shown to be right with God by <u>what we</u> <u>do</u>, <u>not by faith alone</u>.
 - 2. ABRAHAM'S FAITH WAS DEMONSTRATED BY HIS WORKS.
 - 3. <u>Titus 3:8</u> (NASB) This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds. These things are good and profitable for men.

H. THE EXAMPLE OF RAHAB:

- 1. <u>James 2:25-26</u> (NLT2) Rahab the prostitute is another example. She was shown to be right with God by her <u>actions</u> when she hid those messengers and sent them safely away by a different road. Just as the body is dead without breath, so also faith is dead without good works.
- 2. JAMES' POINT: BECAUSE OF HER DYNAMIC FAITH RAHAB RESPONDED TO THE SITUATION WITH HER MIND AND HER EMOTIONS... BUT SHE ALSO RESPONDED WITH HER WILL... SHE DID SOMETHING ABOUT IT.

- a. SHE <u>RISKED</u> HER OWN <u>LIFE</u> TO <u>HELP</u> THE JEWISH SPIES... AND SHE <u>RISKED</u> HER OWN <u>LIFE</u> BY <u>SHARING</u> THAT <u>INFORMATION</u> WITH HER PEOPLE.
 - 1) <u>Hebrews 11:31</u> (NLT2) It was by <u>faith</u> that Rahab the prostitute was not destroyed with the people in her city who refused to obey God. For she had given a friendly welcome to the spies.

6. **CLOSING**:

- A. JAMES 2:14-26 EMPHASIZES THAT MATURE BELIEVERS PRACTICE THE TRUTH IN EVERYDAY LIFE.
 - 1. THAT FAITH IS NOT THE DEAD FAITH OF THE INTELLECTUALS OR THE DEMONIC FAITH OF THE FALLEN SPIRITS.
 - 2. IT IS THE DYNAMIC FAITH OF MEN LIKE ABRAHAM AND WOMEN LIKE RAHAB... FAITH THAT CHANGES LIVES AND GOES TO WORK FOR GOD.
- B. IT IS IMPORTANT FOR EACH PROFESSING CHRISTIAN TO EXAMINE THEIR OWN HEART AND LIFE AND MAKE SURE THAT THEY POSSESS TRUE SAVING FAITH... DYNAMIC FAITH.
 - 2 Corinthians 13:5 (NLT2) Examine yourselves to see if your faith is genuine. Test yourselves. Surely you know that Jesus Christ is among you; if not, you have failed the test of genuine faith.
- C. <u>NOTE JAMES</u> IS <u>NOT</u> SAYING THAT <u>WORKS</u> SHOULD BE "<u>ADDED</u>" TO <u>FAITH</u> (FAITH + WORKS), <u>BUT</u> THAT <u>TRUE SAVING FAITH</u> "<u>INCLUDES</u>" <u>WORKS</u>... WHILCH IS <u>NOT FAITH + WORKS</u> <u>BUT</u>... <u>FAITH THAT WORKS</u>.
