- 1. REVIEW: THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FAITH AND WORKS. (James 2:14-26)
 - A. **DEAD FAITH INVOLVES ONLY OUR MIND**;
 - 1. DEMONIC FAITH INVOLVES BOTH OUR MIND AND OUR EMOTIONS;
 - 2. BUT... DYNAMIC FAITH INVOLVES OUR MIND, OUR EMOTIONS, AND OUR WILL.
 - 3. THE WHOLE PERSON PLAYS A PART IN TRUE SAVING DYNAMIC FAITH.
 - a. OUR MIND UNDERSTANDS THE TRUTH;
 - b. OUR HEART DESIRES THE TRUTH;
 - c. OUR <u>WILL</u> <u>ACTS</u> <u>ON</u> <u>THE TRUTH</u>.
 - d. DYNAMIC FAITH LEADS TO ACTION BY DOING GOOD WORKS.
 - B. IN THE <u>FIRST THREE CHAPTERS</u> OF HIS BOOK, <u>JAMES EXPLAINS</u> THREE <u>CHARACTERISTICS</u> OF <u>MATURE CHRISTIANS</u>:
 - 1. THYE ARE PATIENT IN TIMES OF TROUBLE (JAMES 1).
 - 2. THEY PRACTICE THE TRUTH (JAMES 2).
 - 3. THEY HAVE **POWER OVER THEIR TONGUE**. JAMES 3).
- 2. James 3:1-12 (NLT2) Dear brothers and sisters, not many of you should become teachers in the church, for we who teach will be judged more strictly. Indeed, we all make many mistakes. For if we could control our tongues, we would be perfect and could also control ourselves in every other way. We can make a large horse go wherever we want by means of a small bit in its mouth. And a small rudder makes a huge ship turn wherever the pilot chooses to go, even though the winds are strong. In the same way, the tongue is a small thing that makes grand speeches. But a tiny spark can set a great forest on fire. And the tongue is a flame of fire. It is a whole world of wickedness, corrupting your entire body. It can set your whole life on fire, for it is set on fire by hell itself. People can tame all kinds of animals, birds, reptiles, and fish, but no one can tame the tongue. It is restless and evil, full of deadly poison. Sometimes it praises our Lord and Father, and sometimes it curses those who have been made in the image of God. And so blessing and cursing come pouring out of the same mouth. Surely, my brothers and sisters, this is not right! Does a spring of water bubble out with both fresh water and bitter water? Does a fig tree produce olives, or a grapevine produce figs? No, and you can't draw fresh water from a salty spring.

- A. IN <u>2:14-26</u>, JAMES ZOOMED IN ON HIS <u>CENTRAL</u> <u>MESSAGE</u>: <u>REAL</u> <u>FAITH</u> <u>PRODUCES</u> <u>GENUINE</u> <u>WORKS</u>.
 - 1. THROUGHOUT THE BOOK OF <u>JAMES</u>, A PROBING <u>QUESTION</u> HOLDS HIS WHOLE <u>THEME</u> TOGETHER: "IF YOU SAY YOU BELIEVE LIKE YOU SHOULDN'T?"
- B. IN 3:1-12, HE <u>DEVELOPS</u> HIS <u>GENERAL THEME</u> IN A VERY <u>SPECIFIC</u> <u>DIRECTION</u>: <u>CONTROLLING</u> <u>THE</u> <u>TONGUE</u>.
 - 1. NO OTHER <u>SECTION</u> OF THE <u>BIBLE</u> SPEAKS WITH GREATER <u>CLARITY</u> AND <u>IMPACT</u> ON THE <u>POTENTIAL</u> <u>DESTRUCTIVE</u> <u>POWER</u> <u>OF</u> <u>OUR</u> <u>WORDS</u>.
 - 2. WE MIGHT <u>SUMMARIZE</u> THIS POWERFUL <u>PASSAGE</u> IN THE FORM OF A <u>QUESTION</u>: "IF <u>YOU SAY YOU BELIEVE</u> <u>LIKE YOU SHOULD</u>, <u>WHY DO YOU SAY THINGS YOU SHOULDN'T?"</u>
- 3. JAMES CONTINUES HIS FAMILIAR PATTERN OF WRITING:
 - A. <u>FIRST HE STATES</u> THE <u>PPRINCIPLE</u>: <u>James 3:1-2</u> (NLT2) Dear brothers and sisters, not many of you should become teachers in the church, for we who teach will be judged more strictly. Indeed, we all make many mistakes. For if we could control our tongues, we would be perfect and could also control ourselves in every other way.
 - B. APPARENTLY, MANY IN THE EARLY CHURCH WANTED TO TEACH AND BE SPIRITUAL LEADERS, SO JAMES HAD TO WARN THEM: "Dear brothers and sisters, not many of you should become teachers in the church" (James 3:1).
 - 1. PERHAPS THEY WERE <u>IMPRESSED</u> WITH THE <u>AUTHORITY</u> AND <u>PRESTIGE</u> OF BEING A <u>TEACHER</u> AND <u>FORGOT</u> ABOUT THE <u>TREMENDOUS</u> <u>RESPONSIBILITY</u> AND <u>ACCOUNTABILITY</u>!
 - a. <u>JAMES</u> SAYS THAT THOSE WHO <u>TEACH</u> <u>THE</u> <u>WORD</u>:
 - 1) WILL FACE **STRICTER JUDGMENT**.
 - 2) MUST USE THEIR TONGUE TO SHARE GOD'S TRUTH.
 - 3) MUST PRACTICE WHAT THEY TEACH... OTHERWISE, THEIR TEACHING IS HYPOCRISY.

- C. WHY DO TEACHERS RECEIVE STRICTER JUDGMENT THAN LEARNERS?...
 - 1. FIRST, A TEACHER IS RESPONSIBLE TO SPEAK THE TRUTH... NOT PERSONAL OPINIONS.
 - 2. <u>SECOND</u>, <u>WHAT</u> A <u>TEACHER</u> <u>SAYS</u> <u>AFFECTS</u> <u>OTHER'S</u> <u>LIVES</u>.
 - a. THE RESPONSIBILITY TO TEACH GOD'S WORD ACCURATELY CAN NOT BE TAKEN LIGHTLY.
 - 3. THIRD, TEACHERS ARE EXPECTED TO LIVE THE TRUTH, NOT JUST TEACH IT.
 - a. THE **REAL TEST** OF **TEACHERS** IS **NOT WHAT** THEY SAY, BUT WHAT THEIR **FAMILIES** SAY WITH THEIR ACTIONS.
 - 1) THE EXTENT OF PEOPLE'S MINISTRIES IS NOT THE SIZE OF THEIR CHURCHES/CLASSES... IT'S THE DEPTH OF THEIR FAMILY LIFE.
 - i. <u>TEACHERS</u> MUST <u>NEVER</u> <u>FORGET</u> <u>THAT</u>.
 - 4. <u>JAMES</u> IS <u>NOT</u> <u>CONDEMNING</u> <u>TEACHERS</u>... HE'S <u>URGING</u> <u>SELF-CONTROL</u>.
 - a. AND THIS SELF-CONTROL DOES NOT BEGIN WITH THE TONGUE BUT WITH THE HEART.
 - b. THE **TONGUE** IS JUST THE **MESSENGER** THAT **CARRIES** THE **WORDS** FROM THE **HEART**.
- D. <u>James 3:2</u> (NLT2) "Indeed, we all make many mistakes. For <u>if</u> we could <u>control</u> our tongues, we would be <u>perfect</u> and could also <u>control</u> ourselves in <u>every other way.</u>"
 - 1. James 3:2 ESPECIALLY APPLIES TO TEACHERS:
 - a. <u>NOBODY</u> IS <u>INFALLIBLE</u>... <u>EVERYBODY</u> "<u>MAKES</u> <u>MANY</u> <u>MISTAKES</u>".
 - b. BUT WHEN TEACHERS STUMBLE ... THEY CAN CAUSE OTHER PEOPLE TO STUMBLE WITH THEM.
 - c. IF YOU HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF TEACHING, BUT HAVE A LOOSE TONGUE, JAMES SAYS YOU'LL BECOME THE OBJECT OF GOD'S JUDGMENT.

- E. <u>JESUS</u> TELLS US THAT THE <u>BASIC</u> <u>PROBLEM</u> IS <u>NOT</u> THE <u>TONGUE</u>... <u>BUT</u> THE <u>HEART</u>.
 - 1. THE TONGUE IS JUST THE MESSENGER THAT CARRIES THE WORDS FROM THE HEART.
 - a. <u>JESUS</u> ADDRESSED THE <u>SERIOUS</u> <u>RESPONSIBILITY</u> OF <u>TEACHERS</u>...

 REGARDING THE <u>PHARISEES</u> (WHO WERE <u>TEACHERS</u>), HE <u>SAID</u> IN

 <u>Matthew 15:14</u> "... so <u>ignore</u> them. They are blind guides leading the blind, and if one blind person guides another, they will both fall into a ditch."
- F. THE POWER OF SPEECH IS ONE OF THE GREATEST POWERS GOD HAS GIVEN TO US.
 - 1. WITH OUR WORDS/TONGUE, WE CAN PRAISE GOD, PRAY, TEACH
 GOD'S WORD, ENCOURAGE OTHERS, AND LEAD THE LOST TO CHRIST...
 WHAT A PRIVILEGE!
 - 2. <u>BUT...</u> WITH THAT <u>SAME</u> <u>TONGUE</u> WE CAN <u>TELL</u> <u>LIES</u> THAT COULD <u>RUIN</u> A <u>PERSON'S</u> <u>REPUTATION</u> OR <u>BREAK</u> A <u>PERSON'S</u> <u>HEART</u>.
 - 3. THE ABILITY TO SPEAK WORDS IS THE ABILITY TO INFLUENCE OTHERS
 AND ACCOMPLISH TREMENDOUS TASKS... BELIEVERS MUST NOT TAKE
 THIS ABILITY FOR GRANTED!
- 4. FOLLOWING HIS <u>PATTERN</u>, AFTER GIVING THE <u>PRINCIPLE</u>, JAMES GIVES <u>ILLUSTRATIONS</u> OF THE <u>PRINCIPLE</u>:
 - A. IN ORDER TO <u>IMPRESS</u> ON HIS READERS THE <u>IMPORTANCE</u> OF <u>CONTROLLED</u> <u>SPEECH</u> AND THE <u>CONSEQUENCES</u> <u>OF OUR</u> <u>WORDS</u>, JAMES GIVES <u>SIX</u> <u>ILLUSTRATIONS</u> ABOUT THE <u>TONGUE</u>:
 - 1. A BIT, A RUDDER, FIRE, A POISONOUS ANIMAL, A FOUNTAIN, AND A FIG TREE.
 - B. THESE SIX PICTURES/ILLUATRATIONS FALL INTO THREE CLASSIFICATIONS
 THAT REVEAL THE THREE POWERS OF THE TONGUE:
 - 1. THE **POWER** TO **DIRECT**: A **BIT** AND A **RUDDER**.
 - 2. THE **POWER** TO **DESTROY**: **FIRE** AND **ANIMALS**.
 - 3. THE **POWER** TO **DELIGHT**: A **FOUNTAIN** AND A **TREE**.

- 5. THE **POWER** TO **DIRECT**: A **BIT** AND A **RUDDER**.
 - A. <u>James 3:3-4</u> (NLT2) We can make a large horse go wherever we want by means of a small bit in its mouth. And a small rudder makes a huge ship turn wherever the pilot chooses to go, even though the winds are strong
 - B. IN SELECTING A BIT AND A RUDDER, JAMES USES TWO ITEMS THAT ARE SMALL OF THEMSELVES, YET EXERCISE GREAT POWER... JUST LIKE THE TONGUE.
 - 1. A <u>SMALL BIT ENABLES</u> THE <u>RIDER</u> TO <u>CONTROL</u> A <u>GREAT HORSE</u>... AND A <u>SMALL RUDDER ENABLES</u> THE <u>PILOT</u> TO <u>STEER</u> A <u>HUGE SHIP</u>.
 - 2. <u>SIMILARLY</u>, THE <u>TONGUE</u> IS A <u>SMALL MEMBER</u> IN THE <u>BODY</u>, AND <u>YET</u> IT HAS THE <u>POWER</u> TO <u>ACCOMPLISH</u> <u>GREAT THINGS</u>.
 - C. <u>NOTE</u>: <u>BOTH</u> A <u>BIT</u> AND A <u>RUDDER</u> MUST <u>OVERCOME</u> <u>CONTRARY</u> <u>FORCES</u>.
 - 1. A <u>BIT</u> MUST <u>OVERCOME</u> THE <u>WILD</u> <u>NATURE</u> OF THE <u>HORSE</u>.
 - 2. A <u>RUDDER MUST OVERCOME</u> THE <u>WINDS AND CURRENTS</u> THAT WOULD <u>DRIVE</u> THE <u>SHIP OFF IT'S COURSE</u>.
 - 3. THAT <u>MEANS</u> THAT <u>BOTH</u> THE <u>BIT</u> AND THE <u>RUDDER</u> <u>MUST</u> BE <u>UNDER</u> <u>THE CONTROL</u> OF A <u>STRONG HAND</u>.
 - a. THE <u>EXPERT</u> <u>HORSEMAN</u> MUST KEEP THE <u>POWER</u> OF HIS <u>HORSE</u> UNDER <u>CONTROL</u>.
 - b. AND THE <u>EXPERIENCED</u> <u>PILOT</u> MUST <u>STEER</u> THE <u>SHIP</u> THROUGH THE <u>STORM</u> <u>COURAGEOUSLY</u>.
 - D. <u>SIMILARLY</u>, THE <u>TONGUE</u> ALSO <u>MUST</u> <u>OVERCOME</u> <u>CONTRARY</u> <u>FORCES</u>.
 - 1. WE HAVE AN OLD NATURE THAT WANTS TO CONTROL US AND MAKE US SIN BY SAYING THINGS WE OUGHT NOT TO SAY.
 - 2. SIN ON THE INSIDE AND WORLDLY PRESSURES ON THE OUTSIDE SEEK
 TO GET CONTROL OF THE TONGUE.

- 3. <u>WHEN/IF</u> JESUS CHRIST CONTROLS OUR TONGUE, THEN WE DO NOT NEED TO FEAR SAYING THE WRONG THING... OR EVEN SAYING THE RIGHT THING IN A WRONG WAY!
 - a. <u>Psalm 141:3-4a</u> (NASB) Set a <u>guard</u>, O LORD, over my <u>mouth</u>; Keep <u>watch</u> over the <u>door</u> of <u>my lips</u> (put a <u>watchman</u> at my <u>mouth</u>). Do not incline my <u>heart</u> to any evil thing,
 - b. <u>Proverbs 18:21</u> (NLT2) The <u>tongue</u> can bring <u>death</u> or <u>life</u>; those who love to talk will reap the consequences.
 - c. Matthew 12:34b (NASB) "For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart."
- 4. WHEN JESUS CHRIST IS THE LORD OF OUR HEART, THEN HE IS LORD OF OUR LIPS, TOO.
- E. A <u>BIT</u> AND A <u>RUDDER</u> HAVE THE <u>POWER</u> TO <u>DIRECT</u>, WHICH MEANS <u>THEY</u> CAN <u>AFFECT</u> THE <u>LIVES</u> OF <u>OTHERS</u>.
 - 1. A RUNAWAY HORSE OR A SHIPWRECK COULD MEAN INJURY OR DEATH TO PEDESTRIANS OR PASSENGERS.
- F. <u>SIMILARLY</u>, THE <u>WORDS</u> WE <u>SPEAK</u> CAN ALSO <u>AFFECT</u> THE <u>LIVES</u> OF <u>OTHERS</u>.
 - 1. NEVER <u>UNDERESTIMATE</u> THE <u>GUIDANCE</u> WE <u>GIVE</u> BY THE <u>WORDS</u> WE <u>SPEAK</u>, OR <u>DO</u> <u>NOT</u> <u>SPEAK</u>.
- G. THE BOTTOM LINE: OUR TONGUE IS LIKE A BIT AND A RUDDER:
 - 1. IT HAS THE POWER TO DIRECT.
 - 2. SO... IT IS <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> THAT OUR <u>TONGUES</u> <u>DIRECT PEOPLE</u> <u>IN</u>

 THE <u>RIGHT</u> <u>WAY</u>!
- H. OUR <u>words</u> can <u>build</u> <u>unity</u>... <u>or</u> <u>demolish</u> <u>it</u>.
 - 1. OUR **TONGUE** CAN **ENCOURAGE FELLOWSHIP**... **OR DESTROY IT**.
 - 2. OUR TONGUE CAN FORM COMMUNITY ... OR FRACTURE IT.
 - 3. OUR TONGUE IS A SMALL BUT POWERFUL MEMBER, AND IT HAS THE ABILITY TO DO TREMENDOUS GOOD ... BUT IT ALSO HAS THE POTENTIAL TO DO INCALCULABLE HARM.
