

JAMES – PRACTICAL LESSONS IN SPIRITUAL MATURITY

GOD'S WISDOM CONTRASTED WITH MAN'S WISDOM – JAMES 3:13-18

1. REVIEW: WHERE TO GET GOD'S WISDOM

A. NOTE: GOD'S WISDOM IS RELATING THE TRUTH FOUND IN HIS WORD TO OUR DAILY LIVES.

1. QUESTION: HOW CAN WE RELATE GOD'S WORD TO OUR CIRCUMSTANCES IF WE DON'T KNOW WHAT HIS WORD SAYS?

2. ANSWER: MAKE TIME TO STUDY HIS WORD.

B. SOURCES OF GOD'S WISDOM FOR BELIEVERS:

1. GODS WORD... IS A SOURCE OF WISDOM FOR BELIEVERS.

a. John 8:32 (NASB) "and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

2. TRIALS... JAMES SAYS BELIEVERS CAN GAIN WISDOM BY TRUSTING GOD THROUGH TRIALS THAT ARE SURE TO COME.

a. James 1:2-4 (NLT2)

"Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing" ... INCLUDING WISDOM.

1) James 1:5-8 (NLT2) If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. But when you ask him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do.

3. PRAYER... BELIEVERS CAN ASK GOD TO GIVE THEM WISDOM.

a. James 1:5-7 (NLT2) "If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. But when you ask him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with **divided loyalty** is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. **Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.**

4. JESUS... BELIEVERS CAN GAIN WISDOM FROM THE LIFE OF JESUS.

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- a. Matthew 7:24-27 (NLT2) “Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock. But anyone who hears my teaching and ignores it is foolish, like a person who builds a house on sand. When the rains and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mighty crash.”
- C. KNOWLEDGE ENABLES US TO TAKE THINGS APART... BUT WISDOM ENABLES US TO PUT THINGS TOGETHER... AND APPLY GOD'S TRUTH TO DAILY LIFE.
 1. IT'S RELATIVELY EASY TO TAKE THINGS APART... IT'S NOT SO EASY TO PUT THINGS TOGETHER.
- D. SOMETIMES WE MISS THE HEART OF GOD'S MESSAGE AND FAIL TO MAKE PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS = RELATE GOD'S TRUTH TO EVERYDAY LIFE = WISDOM.
 1. OUR FAILURE TO APPLY GOD'S TRUTH TO EVERY DAY LIFE IS THE “KNOWLEDGE WITHOUT WISDOM” THAT JAMES WROTE ABOUT.
- E. James 3:12-18 SHOWS THE CONTRAST BETWEEN TRUE WISDOM AND FALSE WISDOM (NOTE THE CONTRASTING CONJUNCTIVES = “BUT”, “BUT”, “AND”) USED IN THE THREE DIFFERENT ASPECTS...
 1. CONTRAST IN ORIGINS (3:15, 17a)
 2. CONTRAST IN OPERATIONS (3:13–14, 17)
 3. CONTRAST IN OUTCOMES (3:16, 18)
- F. SEE THE CHART ON PAGE 8: IT CONTRASTS THE WISE AND THE UNWISE:
 1. BY SHOWING A LIST OF OUTWARD SIGNS AND INWARD CHARACTERISTICS FOR BOTH THE WISE AND THE UNWISE...
 2. AS WELL AS THE RESULTS OF LIVING A WISE OR AN UNWISE LIFE.
- G. SEE THE CHARTS ON PAGE 9: THEY CONTRAST THE WORLD'S WISDOM WHICH IS SELF-ORIENTED AND GOD'S WISDOM WHICH IS OTHER-ORIENTED.

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2. CONTRAST IN ORIGINS... WORLDLY WISDOM –VS- GOD'S WISDOM

A. James 3:15,17a (NASB) “This wisdom (worldly wisdom) is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic... But the wisdom from above is first of all pure.”

1. THE CONTRAST IN THE ORIGIN OF WISDOM:

a. JAMES SAYS THAT WISDOM IS EITHER...

1) “FROM ABOVE” (GOD)... OR:

2) “EARTHLY” (WORLDLY/MAN)

3. CONTRAST IN OPERATIONS... WORLDLY WISDOM –VS- GOD'S WISDOM

A. THIS SECTION IS ABOUT HOW WISDOM OPERATES IN OUR LIVES.

B. James 3:13-14,17 (NLT2) “If you are wise and understand God's ways, prove it by living an honorable life, doing good works with the humility that comes from wisdom. But if you are bitterly jealous and there is selfish ambition in your heart, don't cover up the truth with boasting and lying... But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others (reasonable). It is full of mercy and good deeds. It shows no favoritism (impartial) and is always sincere.”

C. SINCE GOD'S WISDOM AND EARTHLY WISDOM ORIGINATE FROM RADICALLY DIFFERENT SOURCES... IT FOLLOWS THAT THEY OPERATE IN OPPOSITE WAYS.

D. THE EVIDENCE (OUTWARD SIGNS) OF WORLDLY WISDOM:

1. James 3:14,16 (NLT2) But if you are bitterly jealous and there is selfish ambition in your heart, don't cover up the truth with boasting and lying. For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder and evil of every kind.

2. JEALOUSY /STRIFE

a. Philippians 2:3 (KJV) “Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.”

b. THE SPIRIT OF SELF-SEEKING CREATES RIVALRY AND DIVISION... ESPECIALLY IN THE CHURCH.

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3. SELFISH AMBITION/ENVY

a. THE WISDOM OF THE WORLD EXALTS MAN... AND THEREFORE ROBS GOD OF GLORY.

b. QUESTION... ARE MY AMBITIONS SPIRITUAL OR CARNAL?

1) DO I REJOICE WHEN OTHERS SUCCEED... OR, DO I HAVE SECRET ENVY AND CRITICISM?

2) DO I FEEL BURDENED WHEN OTHERS FAIL... OR, AM I SECRETLY GLAD?

4. PRIDE/BOASTING... REMEMBER JAMES IS GIVING ILLUSTRATIONS OF FALSE WISDOM.

a. 1 Corinthians 1:31 (NLT2) "Therefore, as the Scriptures say, "If you want to boast, boast only about the LORD."

b. PRIDE LOVES TO BOAST, AND NOTHING IS PROUDER THAN THE WISDOM OF MEN AND WOMEN!

1) THERE ARE WAYS TO REPORT BLESSINGS SO THAT GOD GETS THE GLORY... BUT, THERE IS ALSO A PRIDEFUL APPROACH THAT GIVES US THE PRAISE.

c. WHEN GOD'S WISDOM IS AT WORK, THERE IS A SENSE OF HUMILITY AND SUBMISSION... WANTING GOD TO GET ALL THE GLORY.

1) ... THEN YOU HAVE NO DESIRE TO COMPARE YOURSELF WITH ANY OTHER CHRISTIAN, BECAUSE YOU SEE ONLY CHRIST... AND COMPARED WITH HIM, ALL OF US STILL HAVE A LONG WAY TO GO!

5. LYING/DECEIT

a. THE SEQUENCE IN JAMES 15-16 IS NOT DIFFICULT TO UNDERSTAND:

1) FIRST, THERE IS SELFISH AMBITION THAT LEADS TO JEALOUSY AND STRIFE.

2) THEN, IN ORDER TO PROMOTE OURSELVES WE RESORT TO BOASTING; AND BOASTING USUALLY INVOLVES LIES!

b. NOTE: LIFE IS NOT READ IN OUR PRESS RELEASES... IT'S READ BY THE LORD IN OUR HEART.

E. THE EVIDENCE (OUTWARD SIGNS) OF TRUE SPIRITUAL WISDOM:

1. James 3:13,17-18 (NLT2) If you are wise and understand God's ways, prove it by living an honorable life, doing good works with the humility that comes from wisdom. But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to

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others (reasonable/impartial). It is full of mercy and good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere. And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

2. HUMILITY/MEEKNESS

- a. MEEKNESS IS NOT WEAKNESS... IT IS "POWER UNDER CONTROL".
 - 1) A MEEK PERSON WILL NOT SELFISHLY ASSERT THEMSELVES.
- b. NOTE... THERE IS A FALSE HUMILITY THAT SOME PEOPLE MISTAKE FOR MEEKNESS... BUT, IT IS ONLY COUNTERFEIT.
- c. MEEKNESS IS THE RIGHT USE OF POWER, AND WISDOM IS THE RIGHT USE OF KNOWLEDGE... THEY GO TOGETHER!

3. PURITY

- a. "FIRST PURE" INDICATES THE IMPORTANCE OF HOLINESS... GOD IS HOLY; THEREFORE, THE WISDOM FROM ABOVE IS PURE.
- b. GOD'S WISDOM LEADS TO PURITY OF LIFE... MAN'S WISDOM MAY LEAD TO SIN.
- c. PURITY MEANS MORALLY CLEAN, MARKED BY ETHICAL INTEGRITY... LOVING WHAT IS GOOD, TRUE, AND BEAUTIFUL.

4. PEACE

- a. MAN'S WISDOM OFTEN LEADS TO COMPETITION AND RIVALRY... BUT GOD'S WISDOM LEADS TO PEACE.
 - 1) IT IS A PEACE BASED ON HOLINESS... NOT, ON COMPROMISE.
- b. A PEACEMAKER IS NOT ARGUMENTATIVE, QUARRELSOME, OR BELLIGERENT... BUT ONE WHO BRINGS HARMONY AND UNITY. PROMOTING CLOSENESS, NOT DIVISIVENESS.
 - 1) THE ONE WHO HAS GOD'S WISDOM BRINGS PEOPLE TOGETHER RATHER THAN SEPARATING THEM.

5. GENTLENESS

- a. GENTLENESS CARRIES THE MEANING OF MODERATION WITHOUT COMPROMISE, GENTLENESS WITHOUT WEAKNESS.
 - 1) THE GENTLE PERSON DOES NOT DELIBERATELY CAUSE FIGHTS... BUT, NEITHER DOES HE COMPROMISE THE TRUTH IN ORDER TO KEEP PEACE.
- b. GENTLENESS CARRIES THE IDEA OF BEING EQUITABLE, MODERATE, AND YIELDING.

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- 1) IT IS ABLE TO TAKE AN INSULT OR AN UGLY COMMENT AND
TURN THE OTHER CHEEK WITHOUT RETALIATION.

6. REASONABLE/IMPARTIAL

- a. GOD'S WISDOM MAKES THE BELIEVER AGREEABLE AND EASY TO LIVE WITH AND WORK WITH.

- 1) MAN'S WISDOM MAKES A PERSON HARD AND STUBBORN.
- 2) THE REASONABLE PERSON IS WILLING TO HEAR ALL SIDES OF AN ISSUE... BUT, HE DOES NOT COMPROMISE HIS OWN CONVICTIONS.
 - i. HE CAN DISAGREE WITHOUT BEING DISAGREEABLE.
 - ii. HE IS "SWIFT TO HEAR, SLOW TO SPEAK, SLOW TO ANGER" (JAMES 1:19).

- b. WHEN WE LEAN ON THE WORLD'S WISDOM, WE ARE PRESSURED FROM ONE SIDE AND THEN ANOTHER TO CHANGE OUR MIND OR TAKE A NEW VIEWPOINT.

- 1) WHEN YOU HAVE GOD'S WISDOM, YOU NEED NOT WAVER... YOU CAN BE DECISIVE AND NOT BE AFRAID.
- 2) WISDOM FROM ABOVE BRINGS STRENGTH FROM ABOVE.

7. MERCIFUL

- a. TO BE "FULL" OF SOMETHING MEANS TO BE "CONTROLLED BY."

- 1) THE PERSON WHO FOLLOWS GOD'S WISDOM IS CONTROLLED BY MERCY.
- 2) Luke 6:36 (NASB) "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful."

- b. THE PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN ILLUSTRATES THE MEANING OF MERCY.

- 1) FOR A SAMARITAN TO CARE FOR A JEWISH STRANGER WAS AN ACT OF MERCY = COMPASSION.
- 2) HE COULD GAIN NOTHING FROM IT... EXCEPT THE BLESSING THAT COMES FROM DOING THE WILL OF GOD.
- 3) THE VICTIM COULD NOT PAY HIM BACK... THAT IS MERCY!

8. GOOD DEEDS/"FRUITS"

- a. PEOPLE WHO ARE FAITHFUL ARE FRUITFUL.

- 1) GOD'S WISDOM MAKES LIFE FULL... WITH GOOD DEEDS/FRUIT.

- b. GOD'S WISDOM IS PRACTICAL... IT CHANGES OUR LIFE AND PRODUCES GOOD WORKS (FRUIT) TO THE GLORY OF GOD.

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- 1) John 15:1-5 (NLT2) "I am the true grapevine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch of mine that doesn't produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit so they will produce even more. You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you. Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me.
"Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.

9. SINCERE

- a. WHEN MAN'S WISDOM IS AT WORK, THERE MAY BE INSINCERITY AND PRETENSE.
- b. WHEN GOD'S WISDOM IS AT WORK, THERE IS OPENNESS AND HONESTY, "SPEAKING THE TRUTH IN LOVE" (EPH. 4:15).
- c. WHEREVER YOU FIND GOD'S PEOPLE PRETENDING AND HIDING... YOU CAN BE SURE THE WISDOM OF THIS WORLD IS GOVERNING THEIR MINISTRY.
- d. IT MEANS STEADFASTLY HONEST, AUTHENTIC TO THE CORE.
 - 1) SINCERE PEOPLE WILL NOT DELIBERATELY DECEIVE ANYONE OR EVER APPEAR TO BE SOMEONE HE OR SHE IS NOT.

4. THE CONTRAST IN OUTCOMES... WORLDLY WISDOM –VS- GOD'S WISDOM

- A. James 3:16,18 (NLT2) "For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder and evil of every kind... And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.
- B. WORLDLY WISDOM PRODUCES TROUBLE
 1. James 3:16 (NASB) "For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every evil thing." = TROUBLE
 2. NOTE: ORIGIN DETERMINES OUTCOME... WORLDLY WISDOM WILL PRODUCE WORLDLY RESULTS... GOD'S SPIRITUAL WISDOM WILL PRODUCE SPIRITUAL RESULTS.
 3. COROLLARY... WRONG THINKING PRODUCES WRONG LIVING.
 - a. ONE REASON THE WORLD IS IN SUCH A MESS IS BECAUSE MEN AND WOMEN HAVE REFUSED TO ACCEPT THE WISDOM OF GOD!
 4. THE WORD TRANSLATED "CONFUSION" MEANS "DISORDER THAT COMES FROM INSTABILITY."
 - a. James 3:16a (NLT2) "For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder... = CONFUSION.

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- b. **EXAMPLE:** ONE OF THE MOST **IMPORTANT** THINGS WE CAN **DO** IN OUR **LIVES** IS TO **MEASURE OUR LIVES BY THE WORD OF GOD... NOT BY THE WISDOM OF MEN.**

C. **GOD'S WISDOM PRODUCES BLESSINGS**

1. **James 3:18 (NASB)** "And the **seed** whose **fruit** is **righteousness** is **sown** in **peace** by **those** who **make peace.**"
2. **JAMES RETURNS TO AN ILLUSTRATION OF FRUIT AND INDICATES THAT THERE IS A VAST DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MAN-MADE RESULTS AND GOD-GIVEN FRUIT.**
 - a. **FRUIT** IS THE **PRODUCT OF LIFE**, AND **FRUIT** HAS IN IT THE **SEEDS FOR MORE FRUIT**. (USUALLY IT IS THE **SEED** THAT IS **SOWN... BUT**, HERE IT IS THE **FRUIT** THAT IS **SOWN**).
 - b. THAT **SUGGESTS** THAT AS WE **SHARE THE FRUIT OF GOD WITH OTHERS**, THEY ARE **FED AND SATISFIED... AND THEY IN TURN BEAR FRUIT AND SHARE IT WITH OTHERS.**
3. **EACH OF OUR LIVES IS A LIFE OF SOWING AND REAPING... AND, WE REAP JUST WHAT WE SOW... WE CAN'T SOW WEEDS AND PRAY FOR A CROP FAILURE!!**
 - a. **BELIEVERS WHO OBEY GOD'S WISDOM SOW RIGHTEOUSNESS... NOT, SIN; THEY SOW PEACE, NOT WAR.**
 - 1) **AND... THE LIFE WE CHOOSE TO LIVE ENABLES THE LORD TO BRING RIGHTEOUSNESS AND PEACE AND ENCOURAGEMENT INTO THE LIVES OF OTHERS THROUGH US!**
4. **WHO WE ARE IS WHAT WE LIVE... WHAT WE LIVE IS WHAT WE SOW... AND WHAT WE SOW DETERMINES WHAT WE REAP!!!**
 - a. **IF WE LIVE IN GOD'S WISDOM... WE SOW RIGHTEOUSNESS AND PEACE AND ENCOURAGEMENT... AND WE REAP GOD'S BLESSINGS.**
 - b. **IF WE LIVE IN MAN'S WORLDLY WISDOM... WE SOW SIN... AND WE REAP "CONFUSION/DISORDER AND EVERY EVIL WORK." = TROUBLE!**
 - c. **THE CHOICE IS OURS... TROUBLE OR BLESSINGS!!!**
5. **THE CONSEQUENCES OF APPLYING GOD'S WISDOM THROUGH OUR TRIALS.**
 - A. **TRIAL DEFINED:** A "**TRIAL**" IN LIFE IS A DIFFICULT, UNPLEASANT, OR PAINFUL EXPERIENCE THAT TESTS A PERSON'S STRENGTH, RESILIENCE, AND FAITH... BUT CAN SERVE AS A CHALLENGE THAT CAN FOSTER GROWTH, PERSEVERANCE, AND CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT.

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1. **"TRIALS"** CAN MANIFEST AS HARDSHIPS, OBSTACLES, OR SIGNIFICANT STRUGGLES, OFTEN LEADING TO A PERIOD OF TESTING AND PURIFICATION FOR THE INDIVIDUAL.
- B. **James 1:2-8 (NASB)** "Consider it all joy, my brethren, **when** you encounter various **trials**, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have *its* perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. **But** if any of you **lacks wisdom**, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him. **But** he **must** ask in **faith without any doubting**, for the one who doubts is like the surf of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind. For that man ought **not to expect** that he will **receive anything** from the Lord, being a **double-minded man**, unstable in all his ways."
- C. **WHEN WE EXPERIENCE TRIALS... WE CAN ACTUALLY RECEIVE BLESSINGS AND SPIRITUAL MATURITY IF WE RESPOND BY APPLYING GOD'S WISDOM THROUGH THE TRIAL.**
 1. **NOTE: THE EVIDENCES OF GOD'S WISDOM ARE: PEACE, HUMILITY, GENTLENESS, BEING REASONABLE/AGREEABLE, MERCY, GOOD WORKS, AND SINCERITY.**
 - a. **BECAUSE THERE ARE MOST OFTEN OTHER PEOPLE INVOLVED IN OUR TRIALS WE SHOULD CHOOSE TO RESPOND TO THEM IN: HUMILITY, PEACE, GENTLENESS, BY BEING REASONABLE/AGREEABLE, MERCY, WITH GOOD WORKS, AND SINCERITY THROUGH THE TRIAL.**
 - b. **THAT MEANS WE ARE CONTROLLED BY: PEACE, HUMILITY, GENTLENESS, BEING REASONABLE/AGREEABLE, MERCY, GOOD WORKS, AND SINCERITY... THROUGH OUR TRIALS.**
- D. **THE RESULT: IF WE SOW RIGHTEOUSNESS AND PEACE AND ENCOURAGEMENT THROUGH THE TRIALS (THAT ARE SURE TO COME) IN OUR LIVES... WE WILL REAP GOD'S BLESSINGS!**
 1. **THEN, AND ONLY THEN, CAN WE HAVE AN ATTITUDE OF JOY THROUGH OUR TRIALS!**
6. **THE CONSEQUENCES OF APPLYING MAN'S WISDOM THROUGH OUR TRIALS.**
 - A. **James 3:14-16 (NLT2)** "**But** if you are **bitterly jealous** and there is **selfish ambition** in your heart, don't cover up the truth with boasting and lying. For **jealousy** and **selfishness** are **not God's kind of wisdom**. Such things are **earthly, unspiritual, and demonic**. For wherever there is **jealousy** and **selfish ambition**, there you will find **disorder and evil of every kind**."

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B. THE “FLIP-SIDE” OF RESPONDING TO TRIALS WITH GOD'S WISDOM... IS TO REACT TO THE TRIALS (THAT ARE SURE TO COME) BY APPLYING MAN'S WISDOM (WHAT JAMES CALLS FALSE WISDOM) THROUGH THE TRIAL.

1. THERE ARE OFTEN OTHER PEOPLE INVOLVED IN OUR TRIALS AND WE CAN CHOOSE TO RESPOND TO THEM WITH: SELFISHNESS, STRIFE/FRUSTRATION, ENVY, PRIDE, AND DECEIT/NOT BEING TRUTHFUL.

C. THE RESULT: IF WE SOW SELFISHNESS, PRIDE, STRIFE, AND DECEIT THROUGH THE TRIALS (THAT ARE SURE TO COME) IN OUR LIVES... WE WILL REAP “DISORDER AND EVERY KIND OF EVIL” = TROUBLE!

D. THEN... WE WILL FAIL TO GROW SPIRITUALLY AND LATER WILL MOST LIKELY FACE THE SAME KIND OF TRIAL... WITH A LITTLE MORE DIFFICULTY!

7. CONCLUSION

A. THE CHOICE IN TRIALS SEEMS EASY IF WE CONSIDER THE RESULTS... BLESSING OR TROUBLE.

1. BUT... THE APPLICATION CAN BE DIFFICULT!

a. THAT'S WHY WE ASK GOD FOR HIS HELP.

2. REMEMBER: NOT MAKING A DECISION IS MAKING A DECISION BY DEFAULT!
