- 1. INTRODUCTIONS
  - A. DISCUSS: WHY A STUDY ON PEACEMAKING IS IMPORTANT TO YOU?
- 2. PEACEMAKERS
  - A. <u>DISCUSS</u>: IS <u>PEACEMAKING</u> IS SOMETHING WE ARE OFTEN ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH IN <u>OUR OWN</u> <u>STRENGTH</u>?
    - 1. <u>PLEASE REMEMBER</u>... WE HAVE THE <u>POIWER</u> AND <u>STRENGTH</u> OF <u>THE</u> <u>HOLY SPIRIT</u>!
  - B. PEACEMAKERS ARE PEOPLE WHO BREATHE GRACE.
    - 1. THEY <u>DRAW</u> <u>CONTINUALLY ON THE GOODNESS</u> <u>AND</u> <u>POWER</u> <u>OF</u> <u>JESUS</u> <u>CHRIST</u>, AND THEN THEY BRING HIS <u>LOVE</u>, <u>MERCY</u>, <u>FORGIVENESS</u>, <u>STRENGTH</u>, AND <u>WISDOM</u> TO THE <u>CONFLICTS</u> <u>OF</u> <u>DAILY</u> <u>LIFE</u>.
  - C. RELATIONAL PEACEMAKING, IN ESSENCE, IS THE DESIRE AMD ABILITY TO OBEY JESUS' TIMELESS COMMAND:
    - Matthew 22:37-39 (NASB) "YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.... 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'"
    - 2. <u>DISCUSS</u>: <u>Matthew 5:9</u> (NASB) "Blessed are the **peacemakers**, for they shall be called <u>sons of God</u>."
  - D. AS WE <u>LEARN</u> <u>RELATIONAL</u> <u>PEACEMAKING</u> <u>SKILLS</u>, WE CAN EXPERIENCE MULTIPLE <u>BENEFITS</u>, INCLUDING:
    - 1. <u>STROMGER</u> AND <u>DEEPER RELATIONSHIPS</u> WITH <u>OTHERS</u>,
    - 2. LESS CONFLICT AT HOME (SPOUSE AND CHILDREN), AT CHURCH AND IN THE WORKPLACE,
    - 3. AND BE A MORE COMPELLING WITNESS FOR CHRIST.
  - E. WHEN CHRISTIANS LEARN TO BE <u>PEACEMAKERS</u>, WE CAN <u>TURN</u> <u>CONFLICT</u> <u>INTO AN OPPORTUNNITY</u> TO...

- 1. <u>STRENGTHEN</u> <u>RELATIONSHIPS</u>.
- 2. <u>LIVE MORE JOYFULLY</u>.
- 3. ENCOURAGE OTHERS.
- 4. MAKE OUR LIVES <u>LIVING TESTIMONIES OF THE LOVE AND POWER OF</u> JESUS CHRIST.
- 5. THIS CLASS IS DESIGNED TO <u>HELP EACH ONE OF US</u>, <u>AND OUR</u> <u>CHILDREN</u>, <u>BECOME THAT KIND OF PEACEMAKER</u>!
- 3. <u>THREE DIMENSIONS</u> OF <u>PEACE</u> <u>THROUGH</u> <u>JESUS</u> <u>CHRIST</u>:
  - A. PEACE WITH GOD.
  - B. PEACE WITH OTHERS.
  - C. PEACE WITH <u>SELF</u>.
    - 1. NOTE: IT IS <u>IMPOSSIBLE</u> TO KNOW <u>GENUINE</u> <u>INTERNAL</u> <u>PEACE</u> <u>UNLESS</u> WE ALSO <u>PURSUE</u> <u>PEACE</u> WITH <u>GOD</u> AND WITH <u>OTHERS</u>.
- 4. PEACE WITH GOD
  - A. NOTE: PEACE WITH GOD DOES NOT COME AUTOMATICALLY.
    - 1. BECAUSE <u>WE HAVE <mark>ALL</mark> SINNED</u>... THAT'S THE <u>BAD NEWS</u>.
      - a. <u>Romans 3:23</u> (NASB) for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
      - b. <u>Romans 6:23a</u> (NASB) For the wages of sin is death,
    - 2. <u>BUT</u>... THE <u>GOOD NEWS</u> IS...
      - a. <u>Romans 5:8</u> (NASB) <u>But</u> <u>God</u> demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, **Christ died** <u>for</u> us.
        - 1) DISCUSS: BUT GOD
      - b. Romans 5:1 (NASB) Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

3. <u>BELIEVING IN JESUS</u> MEANS <u>TRUSTING</u> THAT HE <u>EXCHANGED</u> RECORDS (THE ECHANGE LIFE) WITH US AT CALVARY... THAT IS, THAT <u>HE TOOK</u> <u>OUR SINFUL RECORD</u> ON HIMSELF AND PAID IT IN FULL, GIVING US <u>HIS</u> <u>PERFECT RECORD</u>, WHICH <u>OPENS THE WAY</u> FOR <u>PEACE WITH GOD</u>.

a. AS WE:

- 1) <u>TRUST IN JESUS</u>,
- 2) ACCEPT HIS GIFT OF SALVATION,
- 3) AND <u>DRAW NEARER TO HIM THROUGH</u>
  - i. <u>THE POWER OF HIS SPIRIT</u>,
  - ii. THE STUDY AND IMPLEMENTATION OF HIS WORD,
  - iii. <u>THE PRIVILEGE</u> OF <u>PRAYER</u>,
  - iv. AND THE <u>FELLOWSHIP</u> OF <u>HIS CHURCH</u>...
- b. HIS PEACE CAN FILL EVERY PART OF OUR LIFE!

# 5. <u>PEACE WITH OTHERS</u>

# A. IN <u>ADDITION</u> TO GIVING US <u>PEACE</u> <u>WITH</u> <u>GOD</u>, JESUS' SACRIFICE ON THE CROSS OPENED THE WAY FOR US TO ENJOY <u>PEACE</u> <u>WITH</u> <u>OTHER</u> <u>PEOPLE</u>.

- 1. Ephesians 2:14-18 (NIV) For He Himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, by setting aside in His flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in Himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace, and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which He put to death their hostility. He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. For through Him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.
- 2. THIS <u>PEACE</u> WHICH IS OFTEN REFERRED TO AS "<u>UNITY</u>", IS <u>NOT</u> SIMPLY THE <u>ABSENCE</u> OF <u>CONFLICT</u> AND <u>STRIFE</u>.

- a. <u>UNITY</u> IS THE PRESENCE OF <u>GENUINE HARMONY</u>, <u>UNDERSTANDING</u>, AND <u>GOODWILL</u> BETWEEN PEOPLE.
- B. GOD'S WORD CALLS US TO BE AT PEACE WITH EVERYONE.
  - <u>Romans 12:18</u> (NASB) If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with <u>all</u> men.
  - 2. THIS KIND OF <u>PEACE</u> IS THE <u>DIRECT RESULT</u> OF <u>OBEYING</u> <u>THE SECOND</u> <u>GREAT COMMANDMENT</u>.
    - a. <u>Matthew 22:39b</u> (NASB) 'YOU <u>SHALL LOVE</u> YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'
- C. THIS CLASS IS DEVOTED TO SHOWING <u>US</u>, AND OUR <u>CHILDREN</u>, HOW TO <u>PURSUE PEACE WITH OTHERS</u> WHEN <u>CONFLICT</u> HAS <u>DISRUPTED OUR</u> <u>RELATIONSHIPS</u>.

## 6. PEACE WITH OURSELVES

- A. THROUGH JESUS WE CAN ALSO EXPERIENCE PEACE WITHIN OURSELVES.
- B. ALTHOUGH NEARLY EVERYONE <u>LONGS</u> <u>FOR</u> <u>PEACE</u>... IT <u>ELUDES</u> <u>MOST</u> <u>PEOPLE</u>.
  - 1. GENUINE <u>INTERNAL PEACE</u> <u>CANNOT</u> BE OBTAINED <u>BY OUR</u> <u>OWN</u> <u>EFFORTS</u>... IT IS A <u>GIFT</u> THAT GOD GIVES TO <u>THOSE</u> <u>WHO</u> <u>BELIEVE</u> IN <u>HIS</u> <u>SON</u> AND <u>OBEY</u> <u>HIS</u> <u>COMMANDS</u>.
    - a. IN OTHER WORDS, <u>INTERNAL</u> <u>PEACE</u> IS A <u>BY-PRODUCT</u> <u>OF</u> <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>.
    - b. Isaiah 26:3 (NASB) "The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, Because he trusts in You.
    - c. <u>Isaiah 32:17-18</u> (NASB) And the work of righteousness will be <u>peace</u>, And the service of righteousness, quietness and confidence forever. Then my people will live in a peaceful habitation, And in secure dwellings and in undisturbed resting places;
    - d. <u>Psalm 119:165</u> (NASB) Those who love Your law have great peace, And nothing causes them to stumble.
    - e. **Isaiah 48:18** "If only you had paid attention to My commandments! Then your **peace** would have been like a river, And your righteousness like the waves of the sea.

## C. THOSE PASSAGES SHOW WHY IT IS <u>IMPOSSIBLE</u> TO <u>EXPERIENCE INTERNAL</u> <u>PEACE</u> IF WE FAIL TO <u>PURSUE</u> <u>PEACE</u> WITH GOD AND <u>PEACE WITH</u> <u>OTHERS</u>!

- 1. INTERNAL PEACE COMES FROM:
  - a. BEING RECONCILED TO GOD THROUGH HIS SON JESUS CHRIST,
  - b. <u>RECEIVING HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS</u> AND <u>THE POWER</u> TO <u>RESIST</u> SIN,
  - c. AND... THEN OBEYING WHAT GOD COMMANDS.
    - <u>1 John 3:23</u> (NASB) This is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, just as He commanded us.
- 7. <u>BY GOD'S DESIGN</u>, THE THREE <u>DIMENSIONS</u> OF <u>PEACE</u> ARE <u>INSEPARABLY</u> <u>JOINED</u>.
  - A. <u>PEACE</u> WITH <u>GOD</u>, <u>PEACE</u> WITH <u>EACH</u> <u>OTHER</u>, AND <u>PEACE</u> WITH <u>OURSELVES</u> <u>COME</u> IN <u>THE</u> <u>SAME</u> <u>PACKAGE</u>.
    - 1. THEREFORE, IF WE WANT TO EXPERIENCE INTERNAL PEACE, WE MUST:
      - a. BE RECONCILLED TO GOD BY TRUSTING IN HIS SON, AND
      - b. SEEK <u>HARMONIOUS RELATIONSHIPS</u> <u>WITH THOSE</u> <u>AROUND</u> <u>US</u>.
- 8. DISCUSS: ENEMIES OF PEACE:
  - A. FEAR
  - B. ANGER
  - C. ANXIETY
  - D. DISSAPPOINTMENT/UNFULFILLED EXPECTATIONS
  - E. PRIDE
  - F. ENVY
  - G. CONFLICT
    - 1. <u>CONFLICT</u> IS <u>INEVITABLE</u>... IT IS <u>HOW WE DEAL WITH CONFLICT</u> THAT <u>AFFECTS OUR PEACE</u>.
